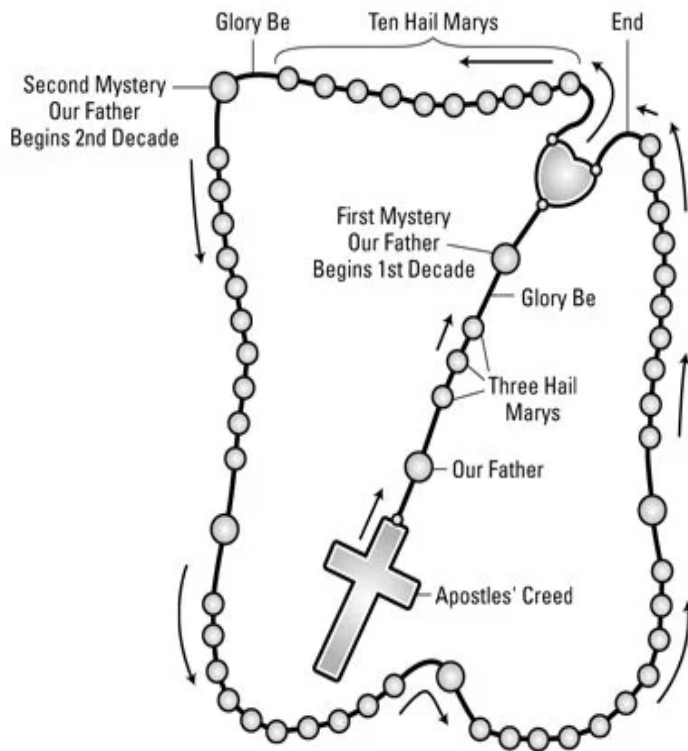
How to pray the Rosary

How do you make a Holy Hour?

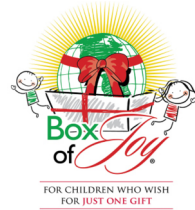
You show up, pray read scripture, speak to Jesus
