Last week my middle daughter
Olivia came home for a few
days visit! Liv has always been fascinated with science,
history and agriculture. So it was no surprise that out of
the million TV channels, both cable and streamed,
she would come across a series of shows combining all
of her interests. Together we binge watched War Time
Farm, Tudor Monastery Farm and Victorian Farm.

Two Archeology Professors and a Domestic Historian spend a year on each of these historical farms in England recreating those time periods only using the equipment of that day to solve the challenges of the farmland, tend the animals and do all the chores needed to physically and financially survive.
