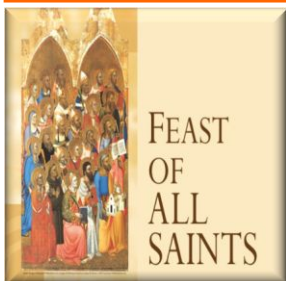

HALLOWEEN AND ALL SAINTS

Halloween is the eve of Hallowmas, better known to modern Christians as All Saints' Day.

Hallowmas celebrates God's harvesting into heaven the faithful of every age, culture and walk of life. It is a day of glorious rejoicing.

Saints are people who, by their joyful service, have extended the love of God to others. The martyrology, the list of the saints officially honored by the church, contains over 10,000 names—and those are only the saints we know of.

All Saints' Day also remembers those holy people whom no one but God any longer knows.

The reading for the day from Revelation describes "a great multitude that no one could count."

This abundant harvest of souls is perfectly suited to observance in late autumn. That's why All Saints' Day and Halloween are brightened with corn shocks, pumpkins, apples, nuts and other signs of natural bounty.

The American tradition of Halloween ghost-and-goblin madness comes from Celtic lands, where the spirits of the dead were believed to roam the earth for one night before winter began.

To ward off their fears of the supernatural, people sat around hug bonfires, telling stories and sharing the fruits of the harvest.

From Me to You....

When my girls were little I had a special basket filled with Arch Catholic children's stories.

Always a favorite was the Book of Saints. They would look at the pictures and Alexa, the oldest, would read the stories of their lives. Saints who were of another time, far in the past, seemingly out of reach. Yet Saints still happen in our lifetime and as All Saints Day is this week, let's learn about the first millennial soon-to-be Saint.

15-year-old Italian Carlo Acutis is the youngest contemporary person to be beatified. The computer whiz died of acute leukemia on Oct 12, 2006. He is on the path to sainthood after Pope Francis approved a miracle attributed to him: The healing of a 7-year-old Brazilian boy from a rare pancreatic disorder after coming into contact with an Acutis relic, a piece of one of his T-shirts.

He is labeled as the "patron saint of the internet," because he created a website to catalog miracles and took care of websites for local Catholic organizations. He was born in London on May 3, 1991, to Italian parents and moved to Milan. As a small child, he showed a strong religious devotion that surprised his non-practicing parents. His mother said that at age 3 he would ask to visit churches they passed. He prayed the Rosary every day from a young age; made his first Holy Communion a year early and then attended daily Mass thereafter; cared for the homeless each night; traveled regularly to Assisi; loved the saints; learned computers to design websites to spread his love of the Eucharist and Mary and to teach about angels and the four last things.

His faith brought his parents conversion!
