
In Eucharistic Adoration, we are adoring the Blood of Christ, which is also contained in the Sacred Host in the Monstrance

Round tables will be set up for each designated hostess who has volunteered to host a table of 6 or 8. The hostess may invite female friends, family or offer open seating.

Every table will be different to reflect the personality of the individual.
