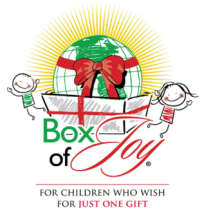
**Holy Family Parish is Participating

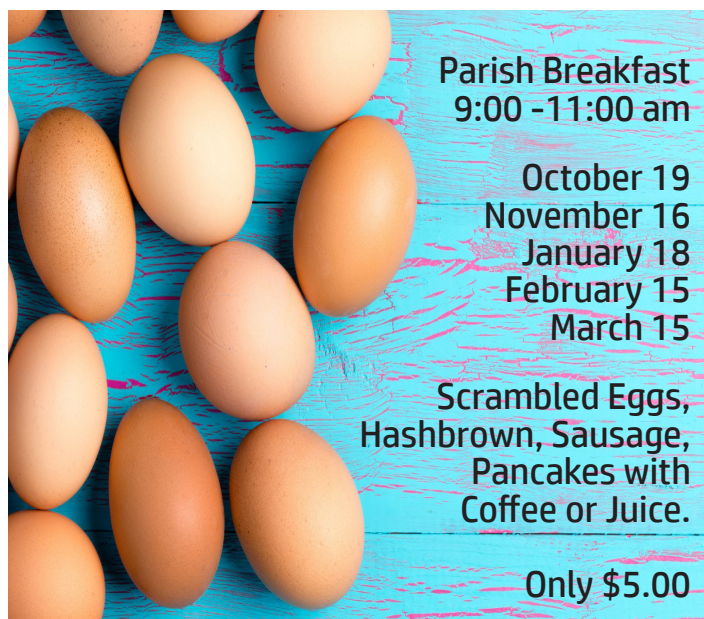
