Dear Friends of the Fairless Community,

As we head into fall, it's time to begin thinking about our Fairless Toy Distribution in November. Families who attend the distribution are often dealing with over welcoming issues: some with health concerns, some are raising children for others, and others are just trying to make ends meet but don't have the extra funds to purchase gifts for Christmas.

It is through the contributions and donations from groups like yours that make each year a success and so many families appreciate it. The Toy Cupboard relieves some of the stress of shopping by providing quality items and by keeping it in conjunction with the Fairless Food Cupboard in a location that is easily accessible near the food distribution center. We provide gifts from newborn to 17 years old. These gifts could include quality toys, games, hats, gloves, socks, gift cards and more.

This year's Toy Distribution will take place on Thursday, November 20th, from 9am- 12pm at the Brewster Friends Church. Families will visit the Food Cupboard at St. Therese Catholic Church first where they will receive a toy voucher, then make their way to the Friends Church to receive toys.


