From Me to You.... Four years ago when I first started here, a member of our Finance Council would tell me that if we lost our revenues from Bingo, financially we would not be able to stay afloat. In my mind I would think, how would we ever lose Bingo? And then 2020 happened. In a few weeks we will publish our year-end Financial Report (the Diocesean fiscal year runs July 1 thru June 30). In the report it shows that we transferred \$70,000 from our Bingo and Festival accounts to cover our expenses.

We owe the success of our Parish to the women and men who dedicated their Friday nights for over 50 years to raise revenue for our Church. They knew the value of their time. Yet they also knew something else... the richness in building community. They found in each other friendships that lasted over their lifetimes.

Next Friday, September 10, we will reopen Bingo after having been shuttered for 18 months. Unbelievable, isn't it? We are not asking for weekly lifetime volunteers. In this day and age life's busyness pulls us all in a hundred different directions each week.

However, what we are hoping to establish is four rotating teams of workers who will spend 3 to 4 hours on a Friday night working Bingo. From selling paper cards to instant tickets to calling back winning Bingo numbers to the Caller. Without these jobs our Church will not exist.

Do you have a friend or two who would enjoy being together to have some fun while working for a great cause? The future of our Parish is in your hands. Please consider volunteering your time to keep our Church open. You will find that in giving of your time, you will receive so much more.

God has a funny way of surprising us like that.
