ADULT SUPERVISION

We are surrounded by water and roads. Although we do everything within our power to make this a safe place, PLEASE LOOK AFTER YOUR CHILDREN. They are our greatest asset.

ARRIVAL

The venue is located at 70 Lawrence Road, Mount Batten, PL9 9SJ. Upon arrival to the Centre, please present yourself to the Reception Area situated down the main access road and turn right, the main entrance faces the pontoon.

This is where you will receive all the information about your visit to the Centre and register your car if you are parked in our car parks. The staff member at reception will go through everything relevant to your visit.

ASSISTANCE OR EMERGENCY

Should you need any form of ASSISTANCE throughout your stay at the Centre, please come to reception and state the help you require and the staff will sort appropriability and call the first aider or emergency services as required.

If a Defibrillator is required, this is mounted just outside the reception area on the wall by the metal stairs. Please ask Reception for the code before removal.

The code can also be obtained when calling 999.

For EMERGENCIES that occur on the water please come to the reception area and staff will telephone the appropriate emergency services.

BAR The Lookout Bar is open to all and will be open from 11.00am until 10.00pm. This is situated on the first floor towards the front of the building.

BOATS Each boat will be assigned a specific parking area. You should have received this information prior to arrival. Please make sure to always park your boat on that same spot.

It is mandatory for ALL support boats to be registered.

BOAT TRAILERS Trailers for RIBS will have to be parked on the designated area. All trailers should be secured by the owner. MBC accepts no responsibility for lost or damage.

BREAKFAST Buffet breakfast is served from 7.00am-8:30am and this is available from the Waterside Room, which is situated on the ground floor on the left-hand side pass the reception area. If you have not already provided dietary information to your main organiser please do so at reception so you can be catered for with any pre booked meals.
