

SBPlayers Covid 19 Policy

Please refer to current government and local guidelines when using this risk assessment

Equipment to be provided:

- Hand washing facilities for regular use
 - Hand sanitizer spray
 - Temperature device for taking temperature on arrival at the location
 - Sign in sheet for all persons attending a session (kept by the organiser)
-
1. Ensure that persons arrive and depart on time with no congregating when at the premises to ensure minimum contact time
 2. Temperatures will be taken and recorded when booking in and all persons attending the session will be booked in accordingly for track and trace unless otherwise notified
 3. Face masks are now not compulsory but are still encouraged to be worn when entering/leaving the premises and removed when in the designated activity area or whilst eating lunch or on drinks breaks
 4. Regular hand washing is encouraged, and sanitizer is available for use throughout the sessions. This will also be encouraged when moving in between activities.
 5. All equipment will be suitable cleaned with appropriate cleaner provided
 6. All windows / extraction fans will be switched on to ensure flow of air
 7. Any participants, staff and volunteers are asked not to attend if they are showing any of the recognised symptoms of Covid-19. These are: high temperature, new and persistent cough, loss of taste or sense of smell. If someone is displaying these symptoms they are urged to get a PCR test done as soon as possible.
 8. If someone does begin to display symptoms during a session that person will be escorted outside and asked to leave (if a minor – parent/carer will be called to collect) and advised to get a PCR test. They will be asked to update the organiser if the PCR comes back positive so all other members can be notified. All equipment will be deep cleaned before any further use.

The SBP Committee is responsible for the regular review, updating and implementation of this Covid-19 policy.
