# Which Approved Hunting Organisation (AHO) is right for me?

To qualify for a NSW Restricted Game Hunting Licence (R-Licence) you must:

- Complete the R-Licence Accreditation Course
- Be a member of an Approved Hunting Organisation (AHO)

An AHO is a hunting organisation that has been approved by the DPI Game Licensing Unit (GLU).

This is an important requirement that means public land hunters have a peer network of responsible and ethical hunters around them.

**You have no obligation to join a specific club.** Your trainer should not influence your decision.



## So which AHO is right for you?

It's wise to pick a club that suits your needs.

Most of the AHOs that are available for you to join specialise in certain types of hunting, so it's a good idea to do your research and choose a club that has your best interests in mind.
