Morrigan 🚄 The Phantom Queen



- Carry the obsidian with you for ongoing protection.

- Shadow Work: Morrigan helps you confront hidden emotions like anger and independence, transforming them into strength. Invoke her during shadow journaling or meditation.
- Protection: Light a black candle and visualize Morrigan's raven form encircling you for protection. Use the affirmation: "Morrigan, shield me with your strength."
- Prophecy: Enhance your intuition by working with Morrigan through tarot or scrying, seeking her guidance for clarity and insight.
- Death and Rebirth: In times of transition, perform a release ritual with Morrigan, embracing transformation and the new beginnings that follow.



## Invocation of Morrigan

"Morrigan, Queen of Battle and Prophecy, I call upon your strength and wisdom. Guide me through the shadows, protect me from harm, and awaken the power within me. Let your raven's wings shield me as I face the unknown. With your wisdom, I embrace transformation and walk the path of my true destiny."

## Correspondences

- Symbols: Ravens, crows, swords, shields, black horses, the cauldron
- Animals: Ravens, crows, wolves, cattle
- Colors: Black, red, dark purple, deep green
- Crystals: Obsidian, black tourmaline, garnet, bloodstone
- Elements: Air (prophecy, communication), Earth (death, rebirth, grounding)
- Plants/Herbs: Yew, blackthorn, mugwort, elderberry, belladonna
- Planets: Mars (strength, war), Pluto (death, transformation)
- Days: Tuesday (connected to battle and strength)
