

Audubon Peer to Peer Aid is a volunteer based, 501(c)3 providing support to Audubon Borough and neighboring communities since 2020. Our mission is to connect people in need with a community that can help.

Our organization started by taking requests from individuals and families that were in need and anonymously posting their request on social media asking the community to help. Volunteers collected donated items and delivered them to the requester. Our organization has grown exponentially over the past few years, and we now maintain a pantry providing non-perishable food and necessities to 31 communities in Camden County. We accept requests through calls, texts, email, and social media and our team of volunteers pack and deliver these requests typically in 1-3 days.

We rely primarily on food donations from the community to stock the pantry and frequently demand exceeds our supply. Our organization also requires financial support to cover operational costs including rent, insurance, and utility bills.
