SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) AND PARTICIPATION IN PUBLIC MEETINGS

On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom declared a State of Emergency resulting from the threat of COVID-19. Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-25-20 (3-12-20) and Executive Order N-29-20 (3-17-20) which temporarily suspend portions of the Brown Act relative to conducting public meetings. Subsequent thereto, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-33-20 (3-19-20) ordering all individuals to stay at home or at their place of residence. Accordingly, it has been determined that all Groundwater Council meetings will be held pursuant to the Brown Act and will be conducted via teleconference. The Groundwater Council meeting was called to order by Tom Crowley at 10:02 a.m. by teleconference.

Roll Call was taken and there was a quorum for voting purposes. The meeting proceeded with the following agenda items.

Agenda Item 1. Approval of Minutes.

1. February 10, 2020, Meeting.

Daniel Cozad moved to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2020, Groundwater Council meeting. Bob Tincher seconded. The motion was adopted by a roll-call vote with the City of Redlands abstaining.

Agenda Item 2. New Business.

- 1. Update on Groundwater Council Participation. Bob Tincher indicated that the City of Redlands and the West Valley Water District (WVWD) are seriously considering joining the Groundwater Council (GC). West Valley Water District will be taking the item to their Board in late April 2020 or early May 2020. Item number three on the agenda was requested by WVWD as one of the incremental steps to joining the GC. There have been staff changes at the City of Redlands and also the pandemic so they have not taken action further action to join the Groundwater Council. Rudy Chow supports the position but needs to better understand the matter. He is being briefed on the matter by Chris Boatman.
- 2. Consider Annual Plan. Matt Howard stated that at the at the February 10th GC meeting, a draft of the annual report was distributed. Comments were requested from the GC by February 28th. The goals of the plan are to report on the conditions of the San Bernardino Basin, the amount paid by the participants, the operations and maintenance activities, and the amount of water recharged. This plan is for 2019 and is a requirement in the framework agreement that an annual plan be prepared each year. Several comments were received and incorporated into the plan. Mr. Howard recommended that the plan be adopted by the GC.

Jarb Thaipejr moved to approve the 2019 San Bernardino Basin Groundwater Council Annual Report. Daniel Cozad seconded. The motion was unanimously adopted by a roll-call vote.

3. Consider Administrative Draft Policy -001 – Revenue Collection. Bob Tincher stated that this item was requested by WVWD. WVWD would like the flexibility to make a single payment to either the San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District or the San Bernardino Valley Water Conservation District for the cost of the water and the maintenance and operations cost. The GC Agreement allows for the GC to change rules, regulations, policies and procedures. Mr. Tincher briefly recapped the Administrative Policy and requested its approval.

Jarb Thaipejr moved to approve Administrative Policy 001 – Revenue Collection. Daniel Cozad seconded. The motion was unanimously adopted by a roll-call vote.

Agenda Item 4. Other Business.

Bob Martin, General Manager of Bear Valley Mutual Water Company, requested that 455 acre-feet of water it delivered to the City of Redlands treatment plant in March be considered GC water. Since the City of Redlands is not a member of the GC, the matter was forwarded to the Operations Committee for an assessment. The GC gave Jeff Noelte direction to prepare a presentation and report since it is a complicated matter and not a simple ask.

The next regularly scheduled Groundwater Council Meeting will be on June 8, 2020, at 10:00 a.m.

There being no further business, Chairman Crowley adjourned the meeting 10:43 a.m.
