

Biblical Time

Many generations pass throughout the narrative that encompasses the first seventy chapters of the Bible. **Biblical Time** documents the ages of each of Adam and Noah's descendants at the time they had their sons and when they died as stated within *Genesis* chapters five and ten.

Biblical Time begins with an articulation of Adam's age when he had his son, Seth (*Genesis* 5.4). Using this verse as a foundation, Adam was born in year 0, had Seth in year 130, and died in year 930. All other dates provided within *Genesis* are built upon this foundational framework of time.

The ages provided for Ishmael, Isaac, and Jacob are provided in later chapters of the narrative (*Genesis* chapters 16.16; 25.17; 21.5; 35.28; 25.26; 47.28)
