1. Event Overview

- 1.1: The Mario Kart 8 Deluxe time trials tournament is a two day event where players can compete in three different divisions to see who can complete the set course the fastest. August 2nd 10am-8pm, August 3rd 10am-4pm
 - 1.2 All Weekend Pass \$100 pre registration: Includes unlimited attempts in Open Division, access for 2 days, access to LAN area.
 - 1.3: Youth Division: \$5 entry fee for 1 attempt
 - 1.4: Open Division 1 & 2: \$10 entry fee for 1 attempt on selected map
 - 1.5: ALL COURSES 150CC
 - 1.6: GRUDGE MATCHES: Learn more at the event :)

- 2.1: Open Division 2 Maps (All Ages)
- 2.2: Youth Division 1 Map (13-below)

3. Game Setup

- 3.1: Each division will have its own set course to compete on (See section5 Tournament Structure).
 - 3.2: Course are as follows: Mario Kart Circuit, Electrodrome, Rainbow Road
 - 3.3: If players decide to bring their own equipment it please tell Mario Kart admins

- 5. Tournament Structure
 - 2 day tournament Aug 2nd and 3rd.
 - Mario Kart 8 Deluxe
 - Youth Division: Mario Circuit
 - Open Division 1: Electrodrome
 - Open Division 2: Rainbow Road
 - You may choose to compete in both of the open division courses,
 you are not limited to 1 choice.
 - Time trials
 - \$1,500 total prize pool
- 6. Tournament Scorekeeping
- 6.1: We will manually input your scores into a leaderboard that will be displayed through a projector. That way you can always see how close you are to the prize!
- 6.2 After completing a time trial attempt, please report your score to the timekeeper and state your name/gamertag and what division/map you raced in.
- 7. Prizes and Awards
 - Youth Division (13 and below): 1 map \$250
 - Open Division (all ages): 2 maps, \$500 Electrodrome, \$750 Rainbow
 Road

8. Code of Conduct

- 8.1: Play Fair: Players will not be permitted to use any exploits or glitches during the game. If you suspect a player of using any unfair advantages, please report these problems to the admin.

If there are any conflicts or issues, address them in a calm and professional manner. This is supposed to be a fun day for everyone so please try to address issues appropriately.
- 8.4: Embrace Diversity and Inclusion: Respect the diversity and backgrounds of all participants in the tournament. Do not discriminate against anyone based on their race, gender, religion, or other personal characteristics.

- 8.6 Multiple Attempts: Players are allowed multiple entries into the same map for an additional cost per attempt OR if you buy the All Weekend Pass you get unlimited.
- 8.7 Eligibility: You must have bought a ticket to CC GameOn to compete in any of the races.

9. Consequences

- 9.1: Glitches: Any attempt made to use a glitch to gain an unfair advantage will result in an immediate disqualification to the tournament.
- 9.2: Sportsmanship: Any inappropriate behavior towards your fellow competitor will be handled as a kick out of the event.
- 9.3: Abuse: Any form of abuse will not be tolerated. This will be handled accordingly.
- 9.4: Drugs/ Alcohol: Will be handled accordingly if found with drugs/alcohol at the event.
