When you arrive at Packer Orchards & Farm Place we ask that the bus pulls to the front of the Red Barn. We ask to please keep the students on the bus until a Packer Orchards team member is present. If a team member is not in sight we ask that an adult come inside to inform us that you have arrived.

The students will then be allowed to get off of the bus and the team member will get a total head count and pass out admission stickers. After that we will do a greeting and lead your class to your designated area.

We will then show you what our self-guided tour stations look like and give each class a map of the farm with where each station is. We will also be supplying each class with a bucket of animal feed to feed our farm friends. We will explain how to feed the goats and the importance of sanitizing your hands afterwards.

If there are any questions during the trip we will be available inside the building.

**Just a few things to remember while visiting us:**

- No going barefoot (we know every little one loves going barefoot but it is just a matter of safety so they don't hurt their little toes)
- This is a family farm so please treat it nicely!
- Treat our animals with respect (please do not taunt or feed the animals with food that is not provided to you)
- Always remember to wash/sanitize your hands after contact with the animals (they can carry diseases that are harmful to humans)
- Remember to clean up your area before leaving, there will be lots of garbage receptacles around to throw away any garbage.
