Announcements:

Brad suggested that we make masks with our logo screen printed on it, to include with merchandise sales. So, said she would check to see if that would be something that our shop would do.

Old Business-

A. Grill Badges- Ad for Grill Badges expires in the April edition of the Self Starter.

B. Name badges- Bonnie and Debbie are going to go to the company who makes our name badges and see what it would cost to make a larger version of our badges. The current cost of name badges to members is \$15.

New Business-

A. All Cadillac & LaSalle Show (Red Apple)- Plan Development

1. Flyer- Bonnie will send Keith a digital copy of the flyer from the 2019 show as reference.
2. Trophy sponsors- we currently have 5 people who have agreed to sponsor trophies. We need 4 more people to sponsor trophies as we have 9 categories altogether.
3. Raffle- Penny will be coordinating the raffle. She will also need more people to help her bring in prizes. We discussed the need for members to start bringing raffle prizes early so that we can have a good raffle. It isn't something we can wait until the last minute to do. Laurie will be reminding people in her monthly calls. Bonnie will send reminder in an email and Rocio will put a reminder notice in the newsletter. We will be once again having the Special Raffle, so please be thinking about prizes that would be included in this type of raffle.
4. Bonnie gave Keith a list of all of the trophy categories that were used in the 2019 show. The board voted to just use the same categories again.
5. Johnny suggested that we do some kind of notification/blitz to ask people to come to the next meeting to help plan the upcoming show.
6. Brad Groff will check to see if the KISN Good Guys are still doing DJ for car shows, and how much they charge. It was mentioned that several people thought that they may no longer be doing this.
7. Brad asked about Covid rules in Clackamas County that might affect the car show. It is an outdoor event, which helps, but we will have to watch the mandates put out by the Governor at the time. We will proceed as if it will happen.
8. CLC Museum Board Elections-
Johnny mentioned that there is a ballot for the CLC Museum Board in the Self Starter this month. He suggested that members pull it out, vote and return it. There are 3 Western Region people running, and it would be good to bring some of the notice to the West, as most of the people who are on the board are from the East. There is information on each of the people running so that you can find out a little about them, and you can vote for up to 15 people. Sandi Terry is very qualified, and is the wife of our Western Region VP. Please consider voting for our Western people.
