Carl Johnson brought a magnificent trophy to show at our meeting. He was given this trophy in recognition for writing a complete manual on how to organize and run a Cadillac Dealership. He shared the history of the Dewards trophy with our group. In 1908 and 1912 three different model Cadillacs were disassembled and reassembled to demonstrate that parts were interchangeable. These cars ran and won a race. The trophy will be sent in loan to a museum. A picture of Carl's presentation will be posted on the website in due course.

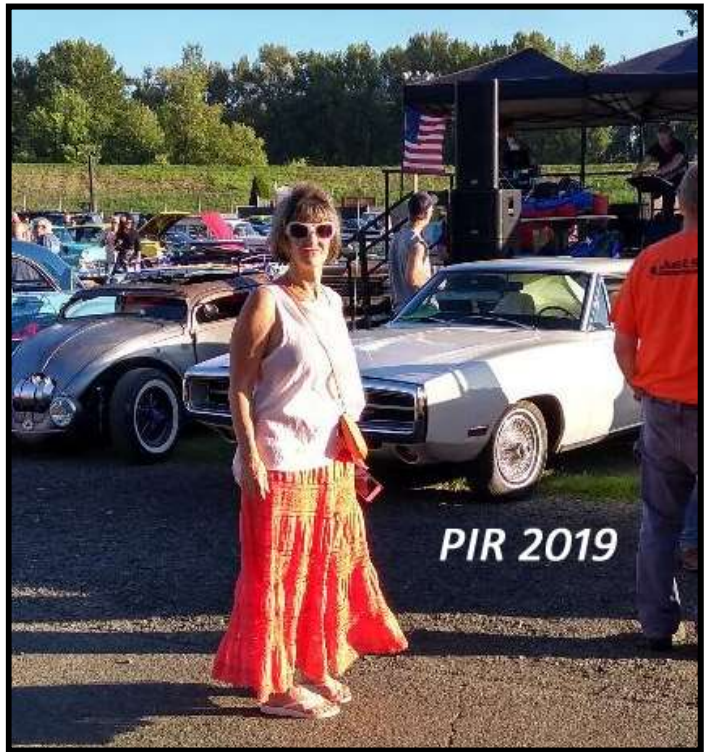
