



HOW DOES THE ADJUDICATOR ASSESS MY PERFORMANCE?

All our adjudicators use the following descriptors when assessing your performance and awarding your mark.

ALL MUSIC SECTIONS		
Mark	Level	Descriptor
90+	Honours	An exceptional performance, showing excellent technique with well planned interpretation. The performance displayed excellent communication with the audience.
85-89	Distinction	An excellent performance with very few technical errors and very good interpretation. The performance communicated well with the audience.
75-84	Merit	A convincing performance with just a few technical errors and with an attempt to interpret the music artistically. The performance was communicated to the audience.
70-74	Pass	A capable performance which displays developing technique and the ability to interpret the music artistically. There were some limits in how the piece was communicated.

ALL solo and duet performers will receive a certificate.

Groups will be awarded one certificate per group.

Trophies: are allocated to some classes and are eligible for those earning a distinction mark.



ALL SPEECH & DRAMA CLASSES		
Mark	Level	Descriptor
90+	Honours	An exceptional performance which is sincere to the intention, content and style of the piece. It commands audience involvement and the voice and movement were used expertly to convey the character of the piece.
85-89	Distinction	An excellent performance showing the ability to evoke an experience above the printed word. The voice and movement were used very well and conveyed the character.
75-84	Merit	A convincing interpretation, showing understanding of meaning and style. The voice and movement were used well and mostly conveyed the character to the audience.
70-74	Pass	A capable performance displaying developing technique and interpretation. The voice and movement are showing development, with some connection to the audience.

ALL solo and duet performers will receive a certificate.

Groups will be awarded one certificate per group.

Trophies: are allocated to some classes and are eligible for those earning a distinction mark.
