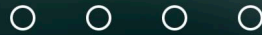

Use the secure connection to your Apple Watch to unlock your iPhone for Siri requests or when an obstruction prevents Face ID from recognizing your face. To unlock with Apple Watch, your watch must be passcode protected, unlocked, and on your wrist close by.



Security Delay Required to Change Passcode

A security delay is required because Stolen Device Protection is active and iPhone is not at a familiar location.

 The security delay will last for 1 hour.

 You will still be able to use your iPhone during this delay. Turning off or restarting your iPhone will restart the delay.

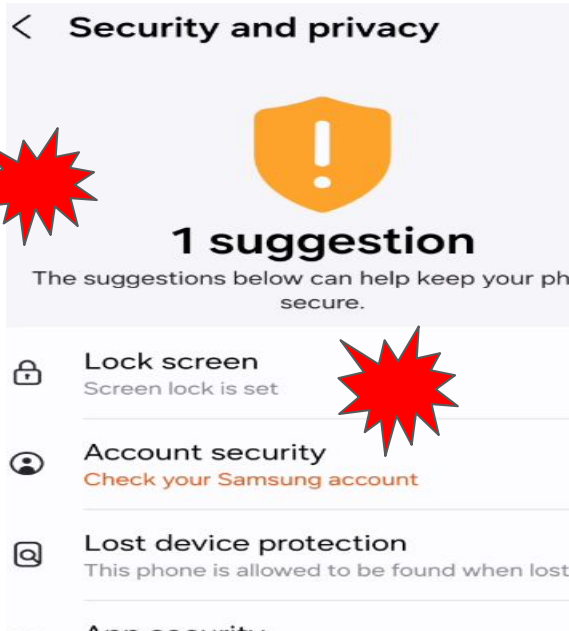
