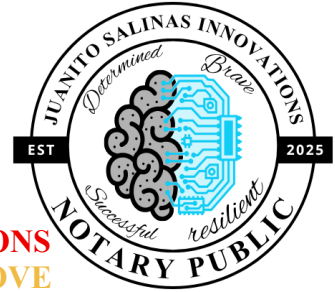

Acknowledgment

Under California Government Code Section 8211(A) Notary Public's may charge a **MAXIMUM FEE** amount of

\$15 Per Signature Notarized for the service listed above (Acknowledgment)

California Government Code Section 8211(A) Description:

- For taking an acknowledgment or proof of a deed, or other instrument, to include the seal and the writing of the certificate, the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15) for each signature taken.

Jurat

Under California Government Code Section 8211(B) Notary Public's may charge a **MAXIMUM FEE** amount of

\$15 Per Individual Taking Oath or Affirmation and Certificate for the service listed above (Jurat)

California Government Code Section 8211(B) Description:

- For administering an oath or affirmation to one person and executing the jurat, including the seal, the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15).

Depositions

Under California Government Code Section 8211(C) Notary Public's may charge a **MAXIMUM FEE** amount of

\$30 For All Deposition Services

+\$7 for Oath

+\$7 for Certificate

for the service listed above (Depositions)

California Government Code Section 8211(C) Description:

- For all services rendered in connection with the taking of any deposition, the sum of thirty dollars (\$30), and in addition thereto, the sum of seven dollars (\$7) for administering the oath to the witness and the sum of seven dollars (\$7) for the certificate to the deposition.

Vote by Mail Ballot Identification Envelopes or Other Voting Materials

Under California Government Code Section 8211(D) Notary Public's may charge a **MAXIMUM FEE** amount of

\$0.00 Per Signature Notarized for the service listed above (Vote by Mail Ballot Identification Envelopes or Other Voting Materials)

California Government Code Section 8211(D) Description:

- No fee may be charged to notarize signatures on vote by mail ballot identification envelopes or other voting materials.

Certified Copies of Power of Attorney

Under California Government Code Section 8211(E) Notary Public's may charge a **MAXIMUM FEE** amount of

\$15 Per Signature Notarized for the service listed above (Certified Copies of Power of Attorney)

California Government Code Section 8211(E) Description:

- For certifying a copy of a power of attorney under Section 4307 of the Probate Code the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15).

United States Military Veterans

Under California Government Code Section 8211(F) Notary Public's may charge a **MAXIMUM FEE** amount of

\$0.00 Per Signature Notarized for the service listed above (United States Military Veterans)

California Government Code Section 8211(F) Description:

- In accordance with Section 6107, no fee may be charged to a United States military veteran for notarization of an application or a claim for a pension, allotment, allowance, compensation, insurance, or any other veteran's benefit.

Copies of Journal Entry

Under California Government Code Section 8206(C) Notary Public's may charge a **MAXIMUM FEE** amount of

\$0.30 Per Page

California Government Code Section 8206(C) description:

- Upon written request of any member of the public, which request shall include the name of the parties, the type of document, and the month and year in which notarized, the notary shall supply a photostatic copy of the line item representing the requested transaction at a cost of not more than thirty cents (\$0.30) per page.

Under California Government Code Section 8206.5 Notary Public's

shall respond to the written request from any member of the public for copies of a Journal Entry within 15 business days for the service listed above (Copies of Journal Entry)

California Government Code Section 8206.5 Description:

- Upon receiving a request for a copy of a transaction pursuant to subdivision (c) of Section 8206, the notary shall respond to the request within 15 business days after receipt of the request and either supply the photostatic copy requested or acknowledge that no such line item exists. In a disciplinary proceeding for noncompliance with subdivision (c) of Section 8206 or this section, a notary may defend his or her delayed action on the basis of unavoidable, exigent business or personal circumstances.
