IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants enrolled or attempting to enroll shall have received the following vaccines in accordance with the doses and age requirements listed below. If, at any time, the age of the child is between the listed ages, the child must have received the number of doses in the "Total Doses Required" column.

September 15, 2003, unless the applicant has had a reliable history of natural disease; or 2 doses received on or after 12 months of age if the applicant was born on or after September applicant has a reliable history of natural disease. 7

2 doses of measles/rubella-containing vaccine; the first dose shall have been received on or after 12 months of age; the second dose shall have been received no less than 28 days after the first dose, or the applicant demonstrates a positive antibody test for measles and rubella from a U.S. laboratory.
3 doses, with at least 1 dose received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born on or or 4 doses, with at least 1 dose received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born after
3 closes, with at least 1 close of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born on or before September 15, 2000, or 4 closes, with at least 1 close of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born after September 15, 2000, but before September 15, 2003; or 5 closes with at least 1 close of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born on or after September 15, 2003. 2 DTaP is not indicated for persons 7 years of age and older, therefore, a tetanus-and diphtheria-containing vaccine should be used.
1 dose received on or after 12 months of age if the applicant was born on or after September 15, 1997, unless the applicant has had a reliable history of natural disease.
1 dose of measles/rubella-containing vaccine received on or after 12 months of age; or the applicant demonstrates a positive antibody test for measles and rubella from a U.S. laboratory.
4 doses if the applicant received 3 doses before 12 months of age; or 3 doses if the applicant received 2 doses before 12 months of age; or 2 doses if the applicant received 1 dose before 12 months of age or received 1 dose between 1 dose if no doses had been received prior to 24 months of age. Pneumococcal vaccine is not indicated for persons 60 months of age or older.
3 doses, with the final dose in the series received on or after 12 months of age; or 1 dose receimenths of age or older. Hib vaccine is not indicated for persons 60 months of age or older.

3 Applicants 7 through 18 years of age who received their 1th dose of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine before 12 months of age should receive a total of 4 doses, with one of those doses administered on or after 4 years of age.

4 Applicants 7 through 18 years of age who received their 1th dose of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine at 12 months of age or older should receive a total of 3 doses, with one of those doses administered on or after 4 years of age.

5 if an applicant received an all-inactivated poliovirus (IPV) or all-oral poliovirus (IPV) series, a divides is not necessary if the 3th dose was administered on or after 4 years of age.

5 if both OPV and IPV were administered as part of the series, a total of 4 doses are required, regardless of the applicant's current age.

6 if both OPV and IPV were administered as part of the series, a total of 4 doses are required, regardless of the applicant's current age.

7 Administer 2 doses of varicella vaccine, at least 3 months apart, to applicant seas than 13 years of age or older at least 4-weeks apart. The minimum interval between the 1th and 2th dose of varicella for an applicant 13 years of age or older is 28 days.
