Please do not submit payment for entries prior to the shows. Fees listed include all four judges. Charges are based on the classes entered at the show. Dual registered horses need only pay the fees relevant to the classes they enter.

The 2025 APHA and AQHA Rule Books are available online. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules of the classes they are entering. Please familiarize yourself with your club rules for high point calculations and year end eligibility.

The Master Entry form is to be completed per horse and must include current horse registration papers, APHA or AQHA membership and the applicable Youth or Amateur card, and APHC or QHAA membership cards. All cards can be uploaded directly onto the entry form. Failure to submit a complete Master Entry will invoke the late fee.

APHC or QHAA Memberships will not be available at the show. Please pay your APHC or QHAA membership prior to the start of the show. Forms are online at www.albertapainthorseclub.com or www.qhaa.ca. Only APHC or QHAA members are eligible for the all-inclusive show fees or year end awards. Please visit your respective club's website for year end award eligibility rules.

All accounts must be cleared prior to leaving the show grounds. Failure to check out and clear your account prior to leaving show grounds will incur a \$50 charge. Blank cheques are to be left with the show secretary as deposit for your account. Accounts can be paid with e-transfer, cash, or cheque. All cheques will be processed upon receipt. Post-dated cheques are not considered payment until the date of the cheque.

Cross Entry is encouraged between APHA, AQHA, and All Breed classes where eligible. Horse/Rider combinations showing in Walk Trot classes are not eligible to compete in any lope classes during the event. In All Breed Small Fry 10 & Under Trail, exhibitors will not be required to work the gate. Certified Helmets are strongly recommended for all Small Fry Exhibitors in under saddle classes.

Class entries and/or changes can be made at the show. All class entries are encouraged to be made ahead of the show to simplify exhibitor check-in. Please remember to check in with the show office prior to your first class. Failure to check in may result in a late fee or missed classes. Office hours will be announced online ahead of the show.

Please notify the gate person of all scratches. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the gate and show secretary are aware of any classes added or scratched!

Drug Testing: All horses will be subject to random drug testing. This may include a urine and/or blood sample collected by a veterinarian or technician. Refusal of testing constitutes disqualification from the show, forfeiture of entry fees, prize monies and awards. This fee is not applied to horses only exhibited in Leadline. Drug testing fee is included in the admin fee.

Splitting & Combining classes: Show management will work with exhibitors to combine or split classes as justified by entries and the 2025 APHA, or AQHA rulebooks.

Yearling and Two-Year-Old Trifecta sponsored by Scattered Spruce Ag Services Ltd: Classes will follow APHA Rules for Longe Line, In-Hand Trail, and Halter. \$500 has been added for Yearlings and \$500 has been added for Two-Year-Olds. Yearling and Two-Year-Olds will enter the same class and show management will split the awards. Entries will be split between Yearling and Two-Year-Old. All three classes must be shown to be eligible for awards. Points will be awarded per placing under each judge in each event and the aggregate score will determine the winner. If you are competing in multiple In Hand Trail or Longe Line classes, the scores will be extracted from the first go - you will not be asked to re-show.

- **In Hand Trail:** Scores will be taken from the first In-Hand Trail class shown. Non-APHA horses will show in their class slot.
- **Halter Class:** Will run as its own class; all ages, all genders combined.
- **Longe Line:** Scores will be taken from the first Longe Line class shown. Non-APHA horses will show in their class slot.

Signature Series Hunter Under Saddle: Will follow APHA Rules for Hunter Under Saddle. Horses must be registered with APHA, AQHA, or APHC. Horses will enter the arena down the centre of the ring at a trot at which time the horse name, sire & dam, owner and exhibitor will be acknowledged.

A/B 2 YO Western Pleasure Walk Jog Stake: Horses will enter one at a time down the centre of the arena for inspection. Horses will show at the walk and jog both directions, and back, and at the discretion of the judge may be asked to exhibit extensions of either gate. Horses must show in a bosal or a snaffle and will be subject to inspection. The class will otherwise follow APHA rules for Western Pleasure. Horses who show in the In Hand Trifecta are eligible to compete.

Futurity Payouts (see separate schedule for CCF) Payments will be issued after completion of the show to horse owners listed on the entry form. Payouts are as follows: **1-2 entries** 90%/10%, **1-3 entries** 75%/25%, **4-6 entries** 60%/25%/15%, **7+ entries** 50%/25%/15%/10%

Supreme Halter sponsored by Eagle Hill Equine: Open to all horses who received a Grand Championship in any gender, from any judge. If there is no Grand for a division or gender, the class winners may enter the Supreme halter class. Eligible horses will show to the WCHA-approved judges for one unanimous winner.

Futurity & Maturities: In all APHC hosted Futurity & Maturities (CCF, Signature Series, and Stakes), the horse owner must be a current APHC member in good standing. Signature Series \$25 held for admin fees. APHC Walk Jog Western Pleasure \$10 held for admin fees.

APHC Highpoint Divisions: see www.albertapainthorseclub.ca/admin for the 2025 Show Highpoint Rules and Divisions

QHAA Highpoints: Only the points earned within that division will be counted towards the High Point Awards. (Example: Only L1 Youth classes will be used in determining the L1 Youth Award. L1 youth classes will not be used in determining the Youth all ages award). **Awarded to:** Amateur, Amateur Select, L1 Amateur, Youth All Ages, L1 Youth, Small Fry 10 & Under, Walk/Trot Youth, Walk/Trot Amateur, L1 Horse, Senior Horse, Junior Horse, and Ranch Horse

Dogs must be on a leash at all times and cannot enter the show/warmup areas and stands.

Vendors wishing to sell products, tack, jewelry, etc. must make arrangements with Show Management. You may not sell anything out of your stall area without the approval of the Show Manager. Vendors must sign an agreement with the hosting clubs and all rules and regulations pertaining to general exhibitors apply to vendors.

Refunds will only be given with a veterinarian certificate or medical note. You must request a refund to the show secretary by the end of the show.

Disputes in regards to prizes or payouts must be provided in writing as soon as possible, and no later than 14 days after the show. Please direct all questions or disputes to Show Management immediately.

Show Management reserves the right to change schedules, arenas, or times at their discretion. The Show Management reserves the right to prohibit any person or horse from showing and has the right to remove any person or horse from the grounds without being liable for compensation.

Photographic images of any exhibitor/spectators are deemed to be acknowledged and permission granted to use in advertising and/or use of media to acknowledge the show, results, or any promotional activity. This includes media contact and interview requests.

Liability Waiver: All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Alberta Paint Horse Club, Quarter Horse Association of Alberta, and Westerner Park, and each their Board of Directors, organizers, staff, and volunteers, shall not be held responsible for any injury or death of person(s) or animal(s), or any damage or loss of property during this event. All horses shall be under the control and management of their owners, exhibitors, and related individuals at all times. All owners, exhibitors, and spectators enter the showgrounds at their own risk. The individuals shall indemnify and save harmless the above mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including, but not limited to, any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the show shall constitute acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions here-in set forth; and only upon this condition are entries accepted.
