ARRIVAL AND STABLING RULES

Important items to know

1. Horses may be moved onto the grounds any time after 9am on Thursday, July 23. Arenas open for riding at 12:00 Noon on move in day. Early arrivals are dependent on Westerner approval and a \$50 early arrival fee. Shavings will be available on a help yourself basis. Stalls must be vacated at the end of the show, Sunday July 26. Failure to Check Out and clear account prior to leaving show grounds will incur a \$50 charge.

2. All stalls will be pre-assigned with reserved names. No changes to the assigned stalls without permission of the Show Management.

3. Requests for stabling location must be made upon reservation and will be accommodated to the best of the show committee's ability. Exhibitors who wish to be stabled together must reserve their stalls under the same name on the entry form provided or risk not being stabled together. Sponsors have priority to stall location. No guarantees are expressed or implied with respect to stall or barn position. No verbal or telephone reservations accepted. Open cheques are not considered as payment for stabling.

4. No hay/feed will be available from the show office.

5. Arrive with a smile, say hi to someone new and lend a hand where you can, :)

6. Stalls that are prepaid are at regular price. Stall prices will increase by \$80.00 per stall after July 10.

7. All cheques/credit cards will be processed upon receipt. Post-dated cheques are not considered payment until the date of the cheque.

8. Stabling Fees and show fees are non-refundable. Refunds with proof of vet / medical certificate only.

9. US Residents: Please pay stabling in Canadian funds only via E-transfer, bank draft, or credit card. Please include in the E-transfer message all details; what is being paid, the trainer's name, your name, etc.

10. The Wild Rose Quarter Horse Show will be run under the American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) and National Snaffle Bit Association (NSBA) Rules and Regulations, unless otherwise noted.

11. Indemnity and Responsibility: All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither The Quarter Horse Association of Alberta (QHAA), Westerner Park, nor any show official of any kind, will be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited, shown, or displayed, or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the

show officials, but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal, or property associated with him, and the exhibitor shall indemnify and save harmless the above mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including, but not limited to, any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the show shall constitute acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions here-in set forth; and only upon this condition are entries accepted. 12. Photographic images of any exhibitor/spectators are deemed to be acknowledged and permission granted to use in advertising and/or use of media to acknowledge the show, results, or any promotional activity. This includes media contact and interview requests.

13. You are responsible for clearing your tab at the show. Statements provided after the show maybe subject to an additional \$50 dollars.

14. Vendors: Anyone wishing to sell products, tack, jewelry, etc. are required to arrange such with QHAA Vendor Coordinator. You may not sell anything out of your stall area without the approval of the Vendor Coordinator. Vendors must sign an agreement with QHAA, if required, and all rules and regulations pertaining to general exhibitors apply to vendors.

15. Management reserves the right to change schedules, arenas, or times at their discretion.

16. The Show Management reserves the right to prohibit any person or horse from showing and has the right to remove any person or horse from the grounds without being liable for compensation.

17. Any exhibitor making an objection to the awarding of any of the prizes or payouts at this Show, shall lodge his or her objection, in writing, immediately after the award is made, but in no case later than 14 days after the Show.

18. Should any question or dispute arise it should be referred to Show Management whose decision is final.

19. Drug Testing: As per AQHA/ QHAA regulations, all horses will be subject to random drug testing. This will include urine and/or blood samples collected by a veterinarian or technician. Refusal of testing constitutes disqualification from the show, forfeiture of all entry fees, prize monies and awards won.
