ART INSPIRATION IDEAS:

- Kids holding a scroll together
 - Fairness in everyday life
- “We the People” filled with diverse faces
 - Freedom growing like a tree
- A balance scale of freedom and fairness
- A bridge built from kindness and justice

AGES 5–12 (as of August 15, 2026)

- Hand-drawn artwork on white paper
 - 8.5” x 11” horizontal layout
 - Scanned at 300 dpi or higher
 - Saved as .jpg or .pdf
- Include one sentence about why the Declaration matters and 1–2 sentences explaining the artwork. Twelve winning entries will be featured on notecards and showcased at the Founders’ Breakfast.

AGES 13–18 (as of August 15, 2026)

- Submit a painting or drawing
 - 300 dpi or higher
 - .jpg or .pdf
- Include one sentence about why voices in democracy matter and 1–2 sentences explaining the artwork. Winning artwork will be displayed at the Museum.
