

The Maricopa County Justice Museum & Learning Center 2024 Art Contest

This year's theme is:

Justice and Natural Resources

We offer two contests:

one for students aged 5-12 by July 15, 2023 to submit drawings that may be featured on notecards to benefit the Justice Museum, and one for students aged 13-18 by July 15, 2023 to submit artwork that may be displayed in the Justice Museum.

All artwork submitted should provide a colorful visual representation of the interaction of law and our natural environment and, separately, a sentence or two about how the artist's work represents this theme. Natural Resources protected by our Justice System include rivers, lakes, oceans, forests, deserts, rangelands, wildlife, plants, minerals, and even night skies. Judges, juries and lawyers play an important role in assuring that we protect safe drinking water, clean air and beautiful natural spaces now and for the future.

NOTECARD CONTEST

Pictures should reflect the artists' visual representation of **Justice and Natural Resources**

DEADLINE: The deadline is July 15, 2023.

HOW TO ENTER: Artists between the ages of 5-12 are invited to submit hand-drawn, homemade artwork (hint: we like color, anything from crayon to paint is great) created on white paper reflecting the theme. Include a sentence about why it's important for our laws to protect our environment. The Contest Committee will choose the winning artwork (12 submissions), which will be featured on notecards to benefit the Justice Museum. Submissions should be horizontal, scanned at 300dpi or higher, and saved as a .jpg or .pdf file. Artists do not have to be formally affiliated with the Justice Museum or the Maricopa County Bar Association to enter, but they do need to be between the ages of 5-12 by July 15, 2023.

WINNERS will be notified by September 15, 2023, will receive a set of cards, and will be invited to attend the Justice Museum Founders' Breakfast in November or December 2023 (date to be determined).

CARDS will be available for purchase to benefit the Maricopa County Justice Museum & Learning Center in November 2023.

ART CONTEST

DEADLINE: The deadline is July 15, 2023.

HOW TO ENTER: Artists between the ages of 13-18 are invited to submit artwork reflecting the theme. Include a sentence about why it's important for our laws to protect our environment. The Contest Committee will choose the winning artwork, which will be displayed in the Justice Museum. Submissions should be scanned at 300dpi or higher, and saved as a .jpg or .pdf file. Artists do not have to be formally affiliated with the Justice Museum or the Maricopa County Bar Association to enter, but they do need to be between the ages of 13-18 by July 15, 2023.

WINNERS will be notified by September 15, 2023 and will be invited to attend the Justice Museum Founders' Breakfast in November or December 2023 (date to be determined). The winner's artwork will be on display at the Breakfast prior to being on display at the Justice Museum.

For best reproduction, drawing entries (5-12 years) must be:

- 1) 8.5"x11" (*horizontal or "landscape" orientation);
- 2) Scanned or photographed at 300 dpi or higher and;
- 3) Submitted as a .jpg or .pdf file

Artist entries (13-18 years) are left to the discretion of the artist. Entry must be:

- 1) Scanned or photographed at 300 dpi or higher and;
- 2) Submitted as a .jpg or .pdf file
