The Maricopa County Justice Museum & Learning Center 8th Annual Art Contest

This year's theme is:

Voices of Democracy

We offer two contests:

One for students aged 5-12 to submit drawings that may be featured on notecards to benefit the Justice Museum, and one for students aged 13-18 to submit artwork that may be displayed in the Justice Museum.

Artwork submitted should provide a colorful visual representation how important it is to be a Voice of Democracy by speaking, listening and sharing ideas within a community. One idea may be What Makes a Good Judge? - Draw a judge in a courtroom where everyone is listening and being kind. or The First Amendment and Protests - Create a scene of a peaceful protest where people of all kinds hold signs about their beliefs. Show how everyone is respectful and safe and, separately, add sentence or two about how the artist's work represents this theme.

NOTECARD CONTEST

DEADLINE: The deadline is August 15, 2024

HOW TO ENTER: Artists between the ages of 5-12 are invited to submit hand-drawn, homemade artwork (hint: we like color, anything from crayon to paint is great) created on white paper reflecting the theme. Include a sentence about why voices in democracy matter. The Contest Committee will choose the winning artwork (12 submissions), which will be featured on notecards to benefit the Justice Museum. Submissions should be horizontal, scanned at 300dpi or higher, and saved as a .jpg or .pdf file. Artists do not have to be formally affiliated with the Justice Museum or the Maricopa County Bar Association to enter, but they do need to be between the ages of 5-12 by August 15, 2024.

Complete the entry form & waiver on the next page.

WINNERS will be notified by September 30, 2024 will receive a set of cards, and will be invited to attend the Justice Museum Founders' Breakfast in November or December 2024 (date to be determined).

CARDS will be available for purchase to benefit the Maricopa County Justice Museum & Learning Center in November 2024.

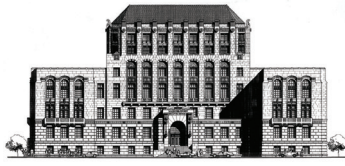
