Interpreting the Levy Analysis

- 1) The last time the Township Levy increased was in 2014 (\$1,200) and 2015 (\$600) which would have added a few dollars more in annual property taxes.
- 2) South Grove decreased the levy in 2018, 2019, and 2022 (\$6,900 total) which would have been an average tax reduction of \$18-\$20 per household.
- 3) Costs have gone up over the past 10 years and with no levy increase coupled with a large levy decrease, we will likely end this fiscal year with a net loss.
- 4) To help stabilize our financial position, South Grove will shift the General Assistance levy portion to the Township and will increase the levy by the cap of 2.9%.
- 5) A 2.9% levy increase adds approximately \$1 per \$1,000 owed in 2026 residential property taxes. (example: \$5,000 paid in 2025 will see a \$5 increase)
- 6) A 2.9% levy increase adds approximately .19 cents per 1 acre of farmland. (example: 100 acres will see a \$19 increase on average)
- 7) These changes will increase the Township budget by \$2,234 next year. This represent one third of the tax decrease in 2).
- 8) Even with the changes above, South Grove anticipates a small next loss next year provided no unexpected costs arise.
