AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

NOTICE

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY AND JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEE.

NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted. **As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

**Two Dog Bathing Stations will be located outside the restroom in the RV Area
and two stations will be located outside the grooming tent closest to the Expo Center.
Trash barrels will be located throughout the grounds. Please help us keep the grounds free of trash.**

An Overnight Parking fee of \$50.00 is required for any vehicle parked on the grounds overnight, regardless of whether the vehicle uses electricity or is occupied. Electricity is available on a first-come, first-served basis. No dogs are to be left on the grounds unattended overnight. Violators will be reported to the Event Committee for further action.

Daily Parking is \$8.00 for one day, **\$14.00** for a 2 day pass & **\$20.00** for a 3 day pass. No passes Mon. & Tues.

All vehicles must park as directed by signage and staff. Please make sure the sign in front of your space is the one you reserved/paid for to avoid having to move your vehicle.

Pavilions parallel to Rings 1 - 10. Pavilion One is reserved for Boxers all three days. Pavilion Two is reserved for sporting breeds all three days. Pavilion Three is closed. Pavilion Four is for crating only - no grooming. No grooming or setup is allowed in the pavilions other than the breeds as designated by signage and the Event Committee.

Catalogs will be available at the Gate, Trophy Table & Club Tent.

Bicycles, Rollerblades, Skates or Scooters are not to be used on the fairgrounds during event hours. These items may be used after event hours and only for the purpose of exercising dogs. No skateboards allowed. For the safety and welfare of children and spectators, NO strollers are allowed under the exhibition tent(s). NO crates will be allowed in the main aisles of the exhibition tents. This is a rule from the Fire Marshal of Monroe County.

Exhibitors/Agents shall be governed by any rules and regulations of authorities and/or facility restrictions in designated areas. Exhibitors/Agents shall stack crates or containers and comply with any limitations in the use of tables or exercise pens as might be required by the Superintendent or Event Committee.

The AAKC reserves the right to limit exhibitor and vendor setup space.

All children must be supervised at all times by a parent or guardian. Any damage to fairground property or resulting injuries will be the responsibility of the individual and/or their parent or guardian. We appreciate your attendance and your compliance with these requirements, as we wish to continue to offer you great dog events at this fine location.
