TO OWNERS OF ROADSTER HORSES:

ARHPA tracks your show horse's ownership via the ARHPA Horse ID Certificate. This official document is necessary because multiple breed registries manage the ownership records of roadster horses of varying breeds and disciplines. *Effective April 1, 2024, the owner must be a current ARHPA member in order to apply for an ARHPA Horse ID Certificate.* The Horse ID Certificate registration is mandatory and should occur promptly when the horse is conveyed to a new owner to ensure accurate recordkeeping. To assist you in avoiding delays or extra fees for obtaining this necessary certificate, we provide the following procedures.

Here's what you need to do:

■ Within 60 days of purchasing or acquiring a roadster horse that will compete in the show ring, ARHPA must receive your Horse ID Application and, after approval, will mail your Horse ID Certificate to you. The original Horse ID Certificate must be promptly provided to new owner when the horse is sold or conveved.

■ After the Horse ID Certificate has been issued for the horse and the horse is sold to a new owner, the new owner must send the original certificate <u>and</u> the Horse ID Transfer Application to ARHPA. (Forms are located at Roadster.show, under the Forms tab.) With

*A convenience fee is charged when you pay by card or PayPal.

■ Be aware that horse show secretaries are being advised of the requirement of the ARHPA Horse ID Certificate; the certificate must be up to date with current owner's information before the horse can be entered at any roadster class at horse shows. This Horse ID Certificate information is available online, free of charge, to horse show secretaries.

Thank you for your cooperation.

An accurate database of records — including the horse's eligibility to show and win prizes — is of paramount importance to all of us who participate with roadster horses. Together, we can build a stronger future for roadster show horses for the generations to come.
