Become a Chaplain Candidate

Candidates who are seeking internship or ordination, who qualify and meet the requirements of the Commission of License and Ordination will be commissioned and receive their credentials as a chaplain and minister by their designation. Those who earn their commission as an ordained Chaplain and minister will be sanction by this church fellowship to perform the sacred duties of the church as a minister of the Gospel of Christ.

The Application Process

All candidates are required to complete the CI application and submit a resume, along with other supportive documents, if any. The process can be completed online on our website or by downloading a copy of the application in PDF format and mail, it back to us by USPS along with other required documentation. Review by the Commission takes approximately 4-5 weeks.
