
**EXECUTIVE ORDER SUSPENDING THE SALE OF ALL PREPARED FOOD AND ARTS  
AND CRAFTS WITHIN THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THE PUEBLO OF ISLETA**

On March 13, 2020 the Pueblo of Isleta Tribal Council enacted Resolution No. 2020-011, Authorization for a Declaration of Emergency and an Emergency Operations Plan, to respond to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. For the reasons stated in Resolution No. 2020-011, and upon direction by the Tribal Council and Tribal Leaders, I, Governor Max Zuni, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the constitution and laws of the Pueblo of Isleta, hereby ORDER and DIRECT:


1. The memo "Community Bakers, Curio Shops and Alfalfa sales to non-tribals" dated April 9, 2020 is rescinded; and
2. The sale of all prepared food, including but not limited to, Indian oven bread or traditional food products, and arts and crafts within the exterior boundaries of the Pueblo of Isleta is suspended until further notice.

This Order supersedes any previous orders, proclamations, or directives in conflict.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until the Governor rescinds it.
