

EXECUTIVE ORDER ALLOWING DINE-IN SEATING FOR FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS

On March 13 2020, the Pueblo of Isleta Tribal Council enacted Resolution No. 2020-011, Authorization for a Declaration of Emergency and an Emergency Operations Plan, to respond to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. For the reasons stated in Resolution No. 2020-011, I, Governor Max Zuni, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the constitution and laws of the Pueblo of Isleta, hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. Food establishments will be allowed to have indoor and outdoor seating with the following restrictions:
 - a. Follow the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidance for restaurants.
 - b. Tables and booths may not seat more than two (2) people.
 - c. Tables, booths, customer waiting lines, and drink fill stations must be separated by at least six (6) feet.
 - d. No more than two (2) customers will be allowed to wait in line and customers in line must maintain at least six (6) feet between customers.
 - e. All employees will be required to wear face coverings and disposable gloves at all times.
 - f. The business will be required to have a protective barrier between customers and staff.

This Order supersedes any previous orders, proclamations, or directives in conflict. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until the Governor rescinds this Order.
