PUEBLO OF ISLETA RESOLUTION NO. 2020-016B

AMENDING RESOLUTION 2020-016A TO CHANGE THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TRIBAL PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER FROM THE CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES

At a duly called meeting of the Pueblo of Isleta Tribal Council of the Pueblo of Isleta, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Pueblo of Isleta (the "**Pueblo**") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe with a written Constitution adopted pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act and with inherent powers of self-government;

WHEREAS, the Pueblo is governed by a Governor and Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the Pueblo of Isleta Tribal Constitution ("Constitution");

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution 2020-016A appointed the Chief Medical Officer to serve as the Tribal Public Health Officer and granted authority to the Tribal Public Health Officer to (1) take necessary actions to protect the public health in accordance with the Communicable Disease Code; and (2) adopt and implement communicable disease emergency response plans, rules, policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Isleta Health Clinic now employs a Director of Public Health Services who will assume the duties and responsibilities of the Tribal Public Health Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Resolution 2020-016A shall be amended to reflect the change in appointment of the Tribal Public Health Officer from the Chief Medical Officer to the Director of Public Health Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Governor of the Pueblo and the Tribal Treasurer shall have the authority to do all that is necessary to effect the intent of this Resolution.
