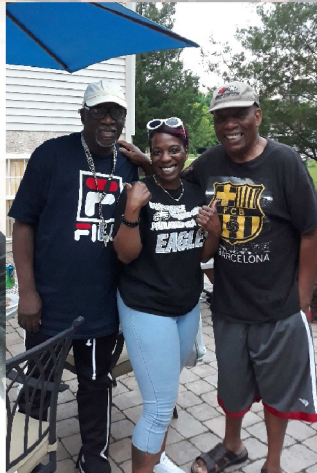
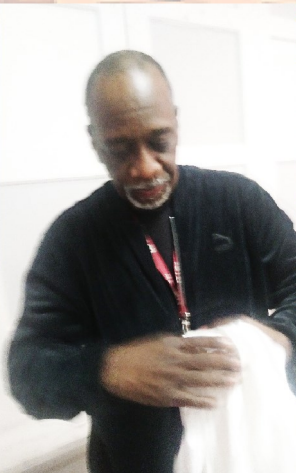


Byron L. Pendleton

I love you Dad rest well.



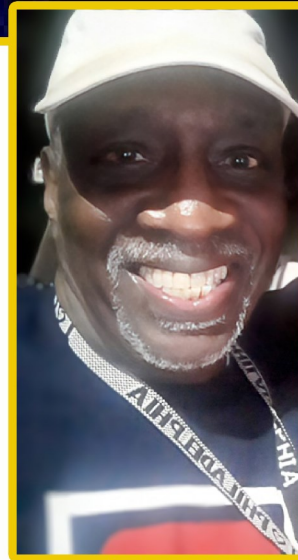
Byron L. Pendleton Obituary
