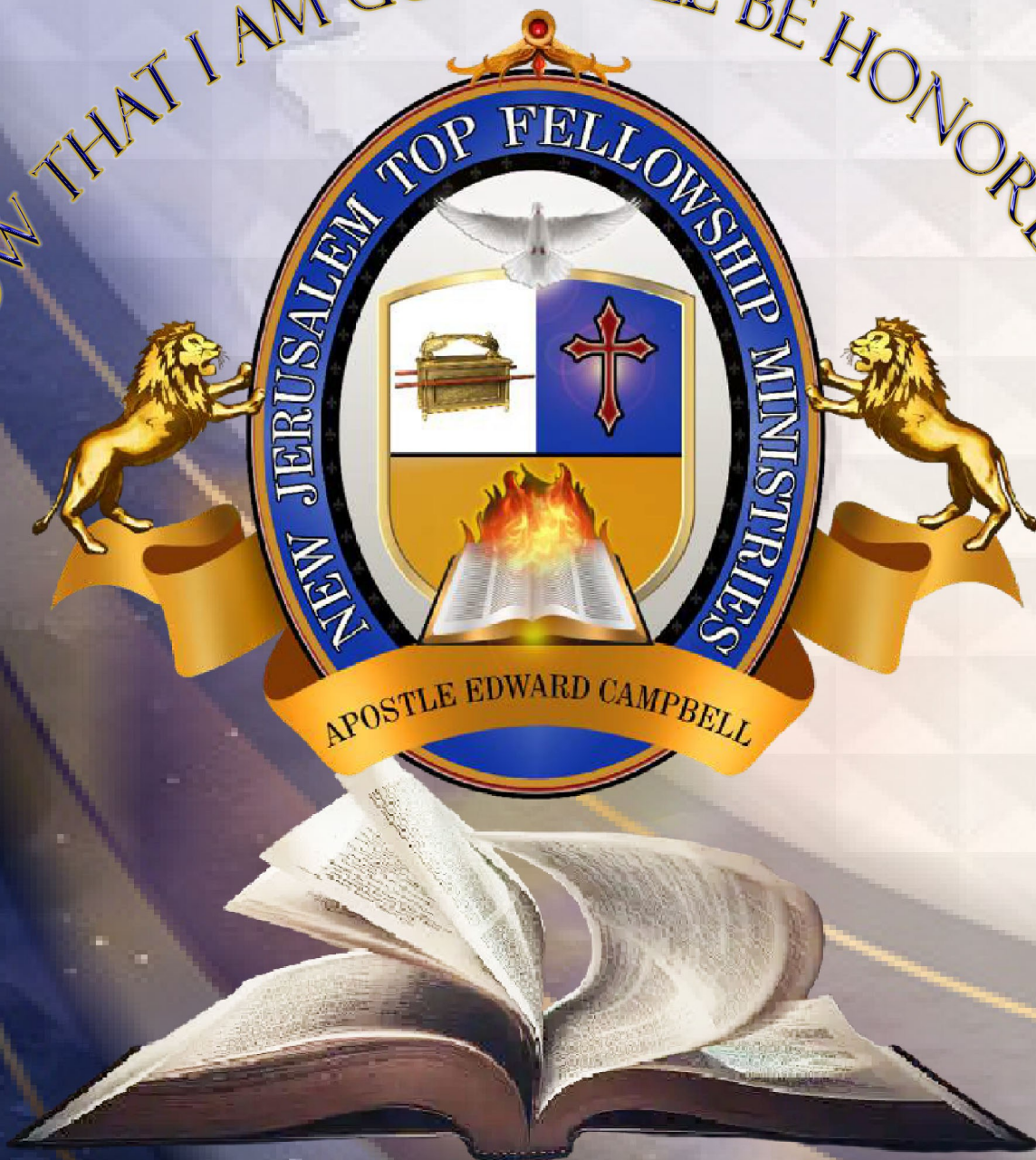


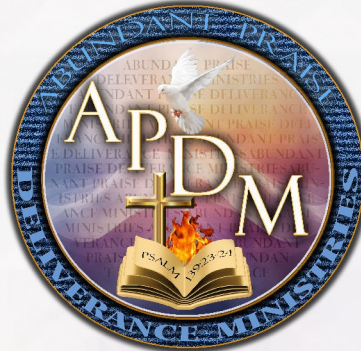

Bishop Leon Pierce Biography

Born on September 7, 1958, Pastor Leon E. Pierce is a native of Newport News, Virginia. He has been the husband of one wife, Missionary Anthonette Pierce, for over 45 years and they are the proud parents of five adult children, many grandchildren and several great grandchildren. While he was yet a child, standing outside of his grandfather's home an older gentleman passed by; and foretold him that he would one day be a preacher of the gospel. This truth began to be fulfilled in the year 1981 as Elder Pierce began to attend the Way of the Cross Church under the leadership of Bishop James C. Jackson. It was there that Bishop Pierce would be introduced to the Apostolic Doctrine, receive water baptism in the name of Jesus Christ, and be filled with the gift of the Holy Ghost. Some months later, in August 1981, Elder Pierce received and accepted the call of God into the ministry of the Word of God and has never stopped pursuing after Jesus Christ since that time.

Over the years, Bishop Pierce would go on to sit under many anointed leaders throughout the Peninsula and the Southside of Hampton Roads including Dr. Merlin L. Ford, Elder John Savage, Elder Frank Mitchell, Bishop Alexander Neville, and Bishop Robert Baker. From each of these leaders he gained great understanding of the scriptures, great love for the church, and submission to the Holy Ghost.

In 1998, after having worked in ministry for nearly 20 years Bishop Pierce was introduced to Bishop William Baker by way of a mutual friend, Mother Ruth Reavis. Bishop Baker, one of the leaders of Cry Aloud, Spare Not Ministries in Newark, New Jersey, became an advocate for Bishop Pierce and in 1999 ordained him as an Elder in ministry. In October of that same year, Bishop Pierce went forth, by the mandate of the Holy Spirit along with Elder Jimmy Banks, began Greater Emmanuel Temple. Since stepping into the pastoral office Bishop Pierce has grown even more in the grace and wisdom of Christ. Countless souls have been baptized in Jesus' name and filled with the Holy Ghost; and launched into the work of the ministry under Bishop Pierce's leadership.

God has entrusted Bishop Pierce with the power of prophetic utterance, spiritually demonstrative teaching, sincere pastoral care, and biblically authentic apostolic authority. Throughout all his experiences, in his over 40 years of ministry, he has remained committed to Christ and the church. He preaches a message of love, forgiveness, holiness, and worship of God in spirit and truth. The key element of his teaching to all those in the Body of Christ whom he encounters is, "he that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith to the churches." He is a strong proponent of hearing God speak daily and walking in that ever-increasing light of revelation. Bishop Pierce is a man earnestly contending for the faith and striving to glorify Jesus in his life so that souls might be saved from the wrath that is to come.

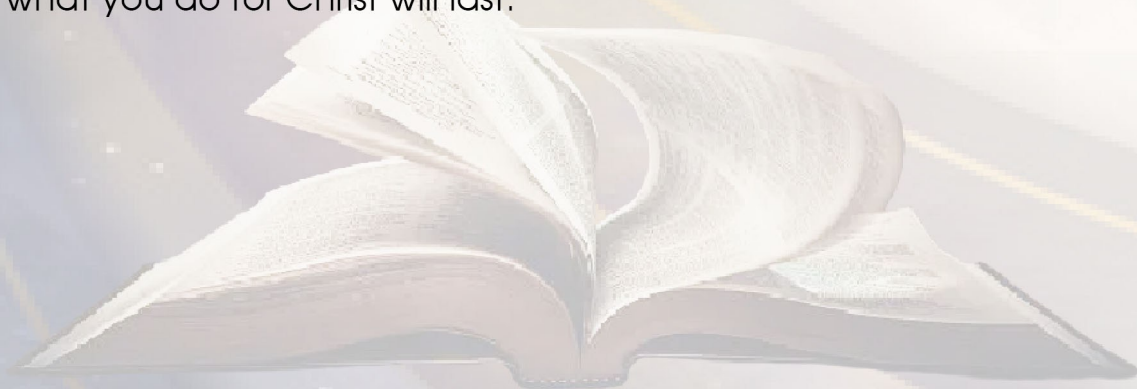
Biography Apostle Raymond N. Stallings

Born to the late Wilbur and Ruth Gary in Newport News, Virginia, Bishop-Designate Robin M. Taft was lovingly adopted by the late Morgan and Frances Parham of Hampton, Virginia. She completed her education within the Hampton City Schools and grew up attending United Bible Way Temple under the guidance of the Honorable Pastor Linwood Stokes.

At the age of 14, Bishop-Designate Taft accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as her personal Savior, was baptized, and filled with the Holy Ghost. She devoted herself to learning the Word of God and actively served in various church auxiliaries, laying the foundation for her life of ministry.

In 1983, a mutual friend introduced Robin to the late Apostle Marvin Taft. Their connection was undeniably divine, and they were married three years later, building a life centered on faith, love, and service. Together, they welcomed their precious daughter and established the Taft family. During this time, Robin built a fulfilling career as a Bus Operator for Hampton Roads Transit, retiring after 28 years—a journey that uniquely prepared her for the ministry God was calling her into.

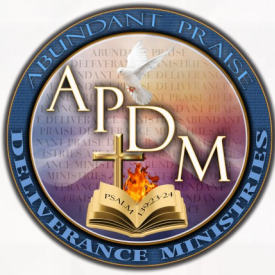

On January 16, 2010, the Tafts were ordained and set in office as Pastors by the Honorable Overseer Apostle Edward Campbell, Jr. of Boston, Massachusetts.

In March 2008, Bishop-Designate Taft was inspired by the Lord to establish "The Daughters of Integrity," a Women's Ministry based on Proverbs 11:2-3. As Founder and President, she has hosted numerous conferences, services, and gatherings, equipping women to walk in freedom and purpose.

Bishop-Designate Taft is a 2009 graduate of Servants in Training School for Ministers and has completed studies at Fullness Bible Institute in Chesapeake, Virginia. She also earned both Associate's and Bachelor's Degrees in Theology from North Carolina College of Theology. Her ministry has extended far beyond her local community as she has traveled to minister at conferences, workshops, and services across the country.

With a heart full of compassion and humility, Bishop-Designate Taft is deeply committed to loving God's people, sharing the message of salvation, and equipping believers to build the Kingdom of God. Her life and ministry are a testament to God's faithfulness and grace.

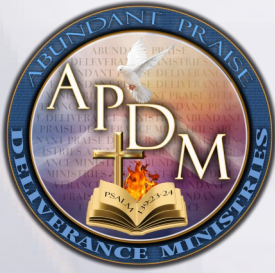

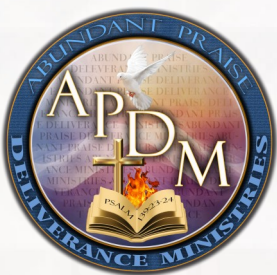

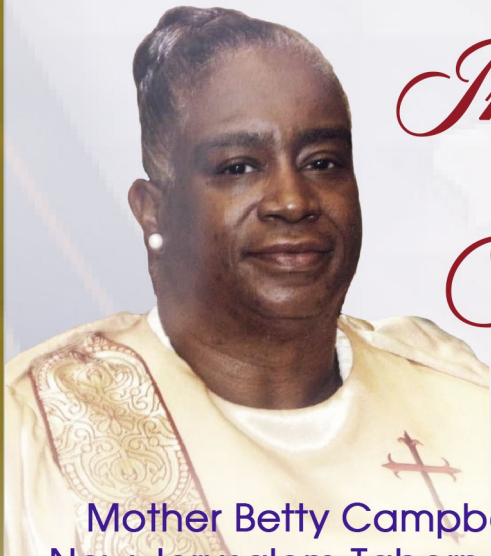
