The topic for this month is *The Breaking Of The New Dawn.* As is my custom when initially taking on a topic, I attempt to: 1) explore the topic at face value; verbatim; and 2) explore the topic to the best of my ability as it adheres to the Word of God.

#### **Perspectives**

**Breaking** (verb) means, in part, that an object is being subjected to a force or element that is causing it to open up and separate into various sections, parts, or pieces. **Dawn** (noun) is the period of day when rays of light shine upon the horizon; permeating the darkness; transforming the night sky with colorful brilliance; it is the phase of the day revealing the coming of the sun's appearance. **Dawn** is the phase of the atmosphere before sunrise. On a symbolic level, **dawn** (verb) means something other than the sun's first traces of its rising. **Dawn** can symbolically represent a state of enlightenment; the realization of a brand new and bright idea, thought, or concept. **The Breaking Of The New Dawn** invokes a sense of newness and awareness that will be the catalyst for growth; that there is something on the horizon of our lives that will shed light upon one's purpose, or upon one's perspective, for the better. **Has it just dawned on you how much I expound upon simple words!** 

The new dawn, in the context that I am using it, refers to a breakthrough in our hearts and walk in Jesus. My message on *The Breaking Of A New Dawn* is an allegory representing a breakthrough that brings forth joy, gladness, peace, and comfort that comes from being more than survivors. We are conquerors. We were tried in the fire, but came forth as pure gold because God loves us and has blessed us beyond measure—*He blessed us with His Holy Spirit and the gift of salvation that is ours, if we only believe.* 

#### **Resolutions and Rebellions**

Jeremiah 29:11 ~ 11 <sup>11</sup> For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

I will do a new thing in you...I will do a new thing in you....

It would be great if the ending of every year meant the beginning of a new year that is without the continued strain and strife of the old; that any turbulence against our quality of life would, if not cease and desist, would at least take a timeout or pause. As this New Year 2021 has proven, that was not the case for multitudes around our nation and around the world. Unfortunately, businesses, educational institutions, medical facilities, and places of worship are still intensely impacted by the invisible (to the naked eye) enemy, the pandemic Coronavirus-19 (COVID-19). To further exasperate matters, our country is facing another threat; a threat that was brewing for years, if not decades.

Jeremiah 18:1-12 ~ <sup>1</sup> The word which came to Jeremiah from the Lord, saying: <sup>2</sup> Arise and go down to the potter's house, and there I will cause you to hear My words. <sup>3</sup> Then I went down to the potter's house, and there he was, making something at the wheel. <sup>4</sup> And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter; so he made it again into another vessel, as it seemed good to the potter to make.

<sup>5</sup> Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying: <sup>6</sup> O house of Israel, can I not do with you as this potter? says the Lord. Look, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are you in My hand, O house of Israel! <sup>7</sup> The instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, to pull down, and to destroy it, <sup>8</sup> if that nation against whom I have spoken turns from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I thought to bring upon it. <sup>9</sup> And the instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it, <sup>10</sup> if it does evil in My sight so that it does not obey My [V]oice, then I will relent concerning the good with which I said I would benefit it. <sup>11</sup> Now therefore, speak to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, saying, Thus says the Lord: Behold, I am fashioning a disaster and devising a plan against you. Return now every one from his evil way, and make your ways and your doings good. <sup>12</sup> And they said, That is hopeless! So we will walk according to our own plans, and we will every one obey the dictates of his evil heart.

#### 117th United States Congress

During recent months, the highest office holder in our land caused an uprising like no other in recent history. Needless to share, by now you know that on Wednesday, January 6, 2021, the most heinous acts against our congresspersons and Capitol police occurred; resulting in at least five deaths to date, and at least 60 injured law enforcement officials. Other disturbing chain of events involved threatening acts involving at least one noose, various types of firearms, and flag poles used to attack and strike at will. Feces and urine was found within the walls of the Capitol. Stolen furniture and equipment and mass destruction of property occurred. Unlike past civil wars, historians and those who lived through perilous periods in history may have been able to shed light on the boundaries of opposing sides; for example, *The North against the South*. What makes what we witnessed on January 6th against our 117th Congress and Capitol so alarming is that the boundaries are not as clearly defined, unless you can draw boundaries as precise and as near as the line between one neighbor to another. *In other words, there are no boundaries—we are unable to distinguish who is who. Have you ever heard the statement: 'Sleeping with the enemy'? Well, this country was sleeping, and has turned a blind eye to the enemy within because it refused to acknowledge the homegrown enemy within its own borders. Now that the rebellion was put down, this nation cannot afford to act like it did not happen—the world is watching and waiting to see what our country will do next.* 

#### **Democracy Wins**

What happened after the riot showed that democracy wins. For all the world to see, our 117th United States Congress collectively demonstrated what is just and right by honoring and upholding their positions by continuing the certification process of President-Elect Joseph Biden and our next vice-president, Vice-President Elect Kamala Harris. We should also give an enormous amount of gratitude towards the staffers who, while their lives were also being threatened, had taken the time to retrieve the ballots. As was reported on various media outlets, the containers that held the Electoral College certificates the lawmakers were counting, but had to leave behind because they were quickly ushered out of the chambers to safety, were retrieved by the staffers. Knowing that several offices and areas of both republican and democratic elected officials were violated; knowing that furniture and electronics were stolen, if there is anything to celebrate in all of this is the fact that these staffers—these individuals—were instrumental in saving and preserving our election results. Needless to express, Year 2020 has been truly a year many of us want to forget; however, if the truth be told, we cannot afford to, lest we (this country, in particular) repeat the same horrible mistakes that not only perpetuated, but fed into the plight we are facing and enduring today. While as I write, thousands are still dying daily because of COVID-19 in these 'united' states. From the pandemic COVID-19, rampant racism, joblessness, homelessness, food shortages, lost of continuity with families, friends, and associates, these issues have seriously challenged many; even those who consider themselves strong-at-heart. We have been blessed to have made it to New Year 2021, and I know we do not take this lightly. We also know that we cannot afford to become stagnant in regrets or heavy thoughts of what we should have, or could have, done. 1 John 4:15-21 ~ <sup>15</sup> Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. <sup>16</sup> And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. <sup>17</sup> Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. <sup>18</sup> There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. <sup>19</sup> We love Him because He first loved us. <sup>20</sup> If someone says, *I love God*, and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen? <sup>21</sup> And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God *must* love his brother also.

We have the ability to give God all the honor, all the glory, and all the praise by being obedient to Him. We have the gift of being able to experience *The Breaking Of The New Dawn* with gladness of heart; knowing that we are in this world, but not of it (The Book of John 17). If God is for us, who can be against us?

If claiming January 1st signifies for you a great time to establish a fresh new start, I hope it was what you desired and beyond your expectations. As it is supported by The Word of God and within His Will for you, may you receive your breakthrough—your dawn. If it pertains to something out of your control or influence, remember that our Lord and God, under the power of The Holy Spirit, has you, so what is for you is for you—if not now, hopefully, soon. Until your breakthrough happens, let your newness begin by glorifying God with a spirit of expectation. Let your newness be founded upon a new level of praise, worship, and purpose in Him. Looking unto man who has blinded your eyes and understanding. To you I say God and God only is our redeemer. Idol promises of grandeur leads to death. Check out history and don't allow it to repeat itself especially when it is dressed up in pride.

Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.

Matthew 15:14 KJV. This is the time in which we must have a keen ear to the voice of God.

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

John 10:27 KJV This must be our understanding so that we are lead across the threshold into the new room of promise.

Otherwise we will receive a different outcome. And the Lord saith, Because they have forsaken my law which I set before them, and have not obeyed my voice, neither walked therein;

Jeremiah 9:13 KJV

Straying away from the principles of God we put ourselves into judgement until such time we humble ourselves and repent for our transgressions.

Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast transgressed against the Lord thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the Lord. Jeremiah 3:13

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. Romans 12:2 KJV

Our focus changes because we are not caught captive in our minds by the world's system of manipulation, but have the lens, knowledge and understanding of Kingdom principles which allows us to actually see the working hands of God in the midst of everything that is going and we can recognize our exit door and cross over the threshold into the new room. He is in the midst of this storm and when you find and recognize Him, He will utter those words to the storm "Peace Be Still". Then you will find yourself in your proper place because you looked to Him.
