Things To Consider When Asking Why?



So, then we see and acknowledge some of the issue. But in our impatience, it is our desire to return back to a place of familiarity without correcting issues that are present. So, we allow the smoldering fire to exist until conditions allow it to reignite and present new found grief. This statement is true if you continue to review the news reviews. One consistency in all cases is how we shift blame to defer from the initial root cause.

So, we cannot afford to return to back to normal because it will not provide the needed change. But usher back the oppression, envy, bias and unnecessary strife. Let create solutions that will line up with of God which is the intended outcome. Let's not go back to anything but go forward to the promises of God based on our obedience to His Word. We don't need to rely on others until we can first rely on ourselves to demonstrate obedience to the Will of God. We must be partakers first. "Do it God's Way for its the best way!




