Perception is the story of my life. I grew up in a Christian home with my mom and her parents. My mother had me at the age of 18 while in her senior year of high school. It was a big surprise for my family, only a very few knew of my mom's pregnancy. When my grandfather took my mom to the hospital with stomach pains, the doctor came out and said, Mr. Guest, everything's fine, the baby is coming. You can imagine the shock on his face.

Growing up, if you ask my family many will say I was spoiled however my perception is just that I was extra loved. It's not my fault that I was the first Grandchild and the first great-grandchild. My Great Grandmother, who we affectionately called Momma, was my favorite person in the whole world. This was mainly because she looked like me. I was what we used to call high yellow with freckles and reddish-brown hair. Momma was also the first person I loved that passed away. I was 6 and remember my mom telling me as we stood leaning against the refrigerator. I remember being at her house and what the house looked like and her black cat that I didn't like. One of my favorite memories was Momma allowing me to eat as many bananas as I wanted. At home, Grandmom would only let me eat 1 a day.

It's funny what memories I can recall from such an early age. Even though Grandpop was usually never home except to sleep, one of my favorite memories is of him cooking breakfast around 4 am before he went to work. He would come into my room and say "Lynn, breakfast is ready".

I would get up, eat breakfast with him and then go back to sleep before I had to get up for school.

Grandmom was like my mom, and I didn't like it. The day I was born, my grandmother quit her job to stay home with me. She's the one who was there in the morning getting me ready for school, having my lunch ready and cooking my dinner. Grandmom taught me how to cook and clean. She was the one that was at all my school functions, except if they were at night, because Mommy was always working.

My mom would not make a decision unless she asked Grandmom first. If I asked my mom if I could go outside, she would say, Go ask Grandmom. My perception became that my mom didn't love me enough to be my mom or something was wrong with her that she couldn't be my mom. Either way, my perception became that it was my fault, and I wasn't good enough.

My next memory is Kindergarten. My school was at the end of my block, and I remember my grandmother walking me to school. I also remember my first encounter with someone not liking me. We were sitting at a round table coloring.

There were two brothers. I don't remember their names, but I do remember they were dark-skinned. I couldn't understand why they were so mean to me. For every crayon I wanted, one of them would snatch it out of my hand and say I want this color. After doing this a few times I decided to give up and go down the slide. When I got to the top of the slide, one of them pushed me down the slide and I remember hurting myself. This is the beginning of my negative perception of myself. Something must be wrong with me because they didn't like me and were mean. My perception

I have yet another memory that goes to my favorite Uncle. He was funny, young, always had money and drove sports cars. He always made me feel special. It wasn't until I was around 8 or 9 years old when I learned that him making me feel "special" was wrong. Now "this is my fault" has become part of my perception.

Most people would think being molested repeatedly for about 5/6 years is pretty bad. Can you imagine what my perception might be if you added being molested by your fourth-grade teacher, a man on a train, and raped twice all by the time you turn 20? My perception became I was only good for sex and that it was engraved on my forehead that I'm easy.

I had a family member who every time they would see me would say do you know you're pretty??..pretty ugly! Yup you guessed it, my perception became that I'm ugly.

I never knew who my father was until I was in the 6th grade. This is when I learned my father was my great Uncle by marriage. In my mind, he had every opportunity to be a part of my life. He easily could have said here is my niece who is unmarried and has a baby. I'm going to step up and be a father figure. But instead, my perception became I wasn't good enough to want or love, I was a reject. It was 3 years after learning who my father was that I was told he molested my mother and that's how I got here. The feelings and emotions turned to pure hatred. And I made sure he knew it!!! But now my perception was also that I was dirty and nasty because of how I was made.

By the time I hit my 20's my perception of true love came in the arms of another woman. The majority of my adult life I lived with that perception. The greatest earliest memory I have is being about 5 or 6 and it was a Sunday morning. We were at church and my Bishop was preaching one of them old school messages about hell. We don't hear these fire and brimstone messages too often anymore. Yes, God is real. He is a loving God, but hell is real as well. Although we may feel like we go through hell here on earth I promise you this is not Hell! Anyway, back to my testimony lol. I was scared and did NOT want to go to hell. So, I went up to the altar for prayer. Once I got home my grandmother sat with me and explained the plan of salvation.

Not only did I grow up in a Christian home but a Christian family. All sides of my family were heavily involved in church. If there is a position in church someone in

family has held that position. Going to church for me was not a chore but I loved it. Growing up Pentecostal we were always in church. It was 2 to 3 nights during the week, Saturday was somebody's rehearsal or something and ALL day on Sundays.

This strong religious presence and trying to sort out my feelings and emotions about my sexuality was a crazy time in my life. My first relationship went on for 6 years off and on. Being taught homosexuality was a sin and trying to understand what I was feeling from my perspective made me feel so unworthy. Again, there had to be something wrong with me. Why did I have these feelings? Why couldn't I pray them away? I was weak. There became a point where I even contemplated suicide.

My last relationship lasted 17 years. Her family became my family, especially after most of my family rejected me including my mother. I will NEVER forget my mom saying I was no longer her daughter. I always said that my partner's children may not have been born from my flesh, but they were born from my heart. We weren't just in a relationship, but she was also my best friend. Even after our relationship as a couple ended, she still was my best friend for another 3 years.

Because of a series of events towards the end of 2017, my life began a spiral downhill for me. By 2018 I found myself slowly slipping down that rabbit hole. I never imagined how dark and deep that hole was. My life was literally turned upside down. I lost what I thought was my family, my home, my job, some friends and even most of my processions. Depression had invaded my life and stress had consumed my body. I didn't want to do anything but stay in bed all day moping and crying. My perception was I was no good. I questioned if I was ever saved, did I ever hear from God. I had made decisions that hurt people I loved and put someone close in danger spiritually. I had the blood of others on my hands. I was in a dark place and couldn't find my way out. Every negative thought, impression and attitude about myself all came to a head.

I developed a system with the person I was staying with. I knew by what time I had to get up, shower and be downstairs like I had been there all day, and everything was fine. I had no appetite and lost so much weight. My hair fell out in patches until I had to cut it all off to make it even. My perception was that I was nothing but a failure. I was a big disappointment to my family, my church family, my friends and most importantly to God. This time it wasn't just a thought, I had a plan to take my life. I knew when, where, and how. My perception was I didn't have anything or anyone to live for and I didn't deserve to live.

The perception of others of where I shouldn't be, God used to keep me alive. I shared some of what I've been through with a cousin and my sister-in-law. My sister in law's response was "Girl you need therapy even if I have to pay for it!" Lol In January 2021 I started therapy with a person who is now my spiritual mother. After our first meeting she said ok, you and I are going to meet twice a week. On TV you see people going to therapy once a week, every 2 weeks, or once a month. My perception was darn I must be really screwed up if I must go twice a week. Little did I know, that was all a part of God's plan to get me where I am now. At the end of

February, I started thinking about moving to Florida. I felt like that was where I was supposed to be. By the end of March, I had packed up my things and moved from Philadelphia where I was born and raised to Florida where the only person I knew was my cousin and her boyfriend. God gave me such peace about Florida being where I'm supposed to be. Not long after moving here, God led me to my church home, now called City of Refuge.

I heard that Celebrate Recovery was having their launch, so I came just to be supportive. In the beginning I just came and didn't say anything. My perception was it's too much like the AA meetings I saw on tv and just couldn't get into it, but I kept coming. Celebrate Recovery continued my counseling and healing. Then came the step study. Every week I would remind them I didn't like step study, but again, I kept coming and was able to get my chip for completing the 12 steps. I will be honest, the inventory was the hardest yet very rewarding. It made me deal with things I had forgotten about or still hadn't really dealt with. The opportunity to make amends freed me in words that are hard to explain.

So, let's recap my perception...

Unlikeable, something is wrong with me, only good for sex, unloved, rejected, ugly, dirty, nasty, not good enough for a few. These feelings of my perception lead me to make decisions and choices that led me farther away from God. My perception could have caused me to turn my back on God or even blame God for letting so many bad deviated things to happen to me at such an early age.

In the Bible there is a wealthy man named Job residing in an area called Uz with his extended family and vast flocks. He is "blameless" and "upright," constantly mindful to live in a righteous manner. (Job 1:1).

Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them. And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? Job 1:6-8 KJV

Don't get me wrong lol by no stretch of anyone's imagination do I or anyone else see me as perfect and upright. But I could you look at my life as imperfect as it may be and hear God saying have you considered my servant Linda? I have lived through what someone else has committed suicide over or has been addicted to drugs or alcohol or sitting in a psychiatric ward or so disconnected mentally and/or emotionally.

It's all in your perception. I see or am learning to see myself as:

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

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














What is Love Part 1

We have looked at mankind's display of love and what motivates them. Now let us see how it stands up against the love God's displayed and displays daily for us.






