Preparing for El Salvador!



Hello, Friends! Hola, Amigos!

We are the Vega family! We would like to share a little bit of our story, history, and calling as missionaries.

Uzi, from El Salvador, and Bethany, from the U.S., met in 2013 while serving and training with Youth With A Mission in Costa Rica. We were married in 2015, got custody of Uzi's daughter, Genesis, and continued to serve as full time missionaries until 2018 when our first son, Isaac was born. We came to the United States for a sabbatical with the purpose of getting Uzi's U.S. citizenship and establishing a connection with our church family before returning to the field. Then, just like the rest of the world, our plans were affected by the sudden appearance of the covid-19 virus. In the waiting, our son Tobías was born in May 2022.

Now, after five and half years of living in the United States Uzi has his citizenship, and we are FINALLY preparing to return to where our hearts belong: the mission field! This coming January, we will be serving Youth With A Mission again, this time in El Salvador as full time staff. We are so excited to pour the gifts and talents God has blessed us with into Uzi's beautiful homeland; to see the resurrection of a lost hope, restoration of the family unit, and to see communities develop into healthy and thriving places! El Salvador (in English, The Savior) has been ravaged by corrupt government and gang violence for decades, but the political atmosphere is shifting. Corrupt politicians are being weeded out and gang members are being imprisoned by the thousands. There is a growing sense of freedom and hope, but the wounds and scars and pain are still there, in need of the healing touch of the Father.

Why El Salvador? In our time in the States, we did a lot of praying and seeking and asking questions about things that God had put in our hearts over the years. What we saw was a pile of puzzle pieces and no idea of where to start. But God spoke confirmation from three people who didn't know each other and were in different countries! God said, "I gave you all the pieces, just start and I will guide you!" So what are those pieces that fit in El Salvador? **Connections, Empowerment**, and **Immersion**.

Connections: The need for mental health workers is enormous and we have already started conversations with mental health care workers here about bringing their training to El Salvador to equip YWAMers and local pastors to be able to minister in this area. We also have a huge desire to see more U.S. church members experience missions in order to be a blessing and to grow in their walk with the Lord. Lastly, we are working to connect/coordinate the pioneering of a new training course for YWAM that focuses on worship, intercessory prayer, spiritual warfare, and evangelism, in order to be more effective in ministry.

Empowerment: We want to see the Salvadorans take ownership in the growth and restoration of their country. We believe that God has connected us to key people and ministries for the task of equipping the people so that they can rise up and take hold of the blessings God has for them.

Immersion: Before we were married, we talked and prayed about how we wanted to raise our kids and what things were important to us as individuals, but also as a missionary family. Our desire is to live with a diverse "Kingdom culture", where the best parts of our cultures are drawn out to honor God. We want to have our kids immersed in Salvadoran culture so that part of their heritage is not lost.

Who/what is Youth With A Mission? Youth with a Mission (YWAM) is an international and interdenominational Christian training organization founded in 1960. The three focuses are in training, mercy ministries, and evangelism with the goal of seeing God in each of the 7 spheres of society (family, economics, government, religion, education, media, and the arts). There are more than 1,200 working locations in over 180 countries. Each year approximately 25,000 short term missionaries are sent around the globe.

What will we be doing? As full time staff, we will have general operations responsibilities (i.e. property maintenance, kitchen duties, hospitality, etc.), work utilizing our gifts and talents (i.e. Spanish/English translation, administration, discipling/mentoring, etc.), and being involved with ministries of the base (i.e. mercy ministries, kids programs, Bible and literacy classes, etc.). **So what might our day look like?** In the morning, we may be preparing breakfast for a team that has come to build a home for a single mother in the community. After breakfast, Uzi could be translating for classes while Bethany homeschools and works in communications. After lunch, we prepare for kids ministry (a hot meal and a fun Bible study out in the community) or helping to build the house with the team. On the way back from ministry, we might stop to do the grocery shopping for the base meals for the rest of the week. More translating for Uzi for evening classes! Before dinner, someone needs to talk and process; Bethany can help with that! Dinner might be done, but the day is not finished; time to sort through the vegetable donations that have just been dropped off. Now we can rest for another busy day!





I wrote my first song at the age of 12 years in 1971. During that time, I wanted so badly to be Michael Jackson of the Jackson-5 my favorite music group to this day. I try to hit the hi Michael notes, to no avail. I attempt the dance steps as best I could. Why? I wanted to be a singer and performer like my music hero. By the time I graduates high school. I had already written about a good 50 songs and performed them in front of friends and family trying again to imitate MJ and the Jacksons.

It was also around this time, 1977ish that I recommitted my life to the Lord (I was saved at 12) and a new direction was presented to me. One that included a calling or a divine appointment if you please. I had no idea what being called to the ministry was outside of pulpit preaching. I knew how to work a crowd and put on a show. But, to minister in the Spirit, I had no clue. I grew up in the COGIC denomination but later at age 18, moved to a Pentecostal Independent church where I joined the choir and learned the difference between performing in the flesh and ministering in the Spirit. It was an eye-opening experience. Years later, I was ordained a Deacon, and years later I was ordained an Evangelist. All this while perfecting my craft of songwriting and biblical studies. I sang professionally from 1971 to 2004 and went as far as Johannesburg, South Africa as well as throughout the US sharing the Gospel through song.

From a child, I wanted to make a living singing and performing music. During the 43 years I traveled with my music, I never got to the level of being able to sustain a living as I dreamed. So, being discouraged, I stopped recording (released 4 albums) and only sang at my home church in Philadelphia. I figured, if God wants me to sing outside the four walls of my home church, he'd open the doors and provide the resources. It's expensive taking a ministry on the road regardless of the size and I didn't have it.

As Peter and the disciples did after his crucifixion, they went back to fishing and their previous profession. This was because they assumed their ministry with Christ had hit it's limit and their dream of going national (so to speak) was over. Jesus appeared to them and made the needed attitude adjustments (Peter, do you love me?) and sent them on their way. Then on the day of Pentecost, all HEAVEN broke lose, literally. The years they spent with Jesus ($3\frac{1}{2}$) the lessons taught, the persecutions endured, and above all, the waiting for the fulfillment of the promise,

all paid off. And today you and I are believers because they remembered their calling, went back to their calling, went forth with their calling and abode in their calling.

Many of us have an idea as to how we view our ministry, including the direction we want it to go and the impact we want to make. As the scriptures brings out, some do it for filthy material gains and fame (I Peter 5:2) and (Acts 8:13). I actually told the Lord, I would return to my music ministry and release recordings, but wasn't looking to or interested in traveling (touring). Trust me, it's grueling! The Lord, very patiently reminded me, 1. He is Lord, 2. He called me, 3. He gifted me, and it is He who is sending me. I just received that full revelation this morning.

So, as I and many others who were so stubborn, brazen and bold enough to tell the Lord what we were going to do and when; gird up the loins of our minds and resume our called assignments. I would encourage you to do the same. Gifts were made to be given and shared. Let's make our calling and election sure.


