Can we disparage the existence of God, or can we explain Him? Who sustains the duration of life & who allows it to take place?


Or who can stop the aging process except the hand of God? Or who can set the moon in place before a new day dawns?

What Makes a Lasting Relationship

68 years of marriage, 53 years of marriage these were relationships brought together in their late teens and mid-twenties. Without a whole lot of distractions. When asked if they had to do it all again and with same spouse the answer was an outstanding yes. They enjoyed being with their partner.

Today fewer couples are experiencing this sort of longevity. There are several factors that contribute to short tenure marriages. Infidelity being the most common factor, physical and emotional abuse, a non-contributing spouse, substance abuse (alcohol/drug) and/or physical abuse. So minor infractions, religious differences as well as lack of motivation or loss of interest where there is little to no interaction. Separation without explanation, too much family or friend uninvited interaction or intervention. Comparing one's partner to another, demonstrating a lack of respect by uttering personality put downs. Or, grouping them with a certain gender or culture stereotypes failing to recognize them as a independent individual.

For successful marriages they have the understanding that there is no I in team. They have also removed the stereotypes within the house and learned how to do things equally. Consider their mate when making decisions that could have minor or major impacts.

One of the most significant things in a successful relationship is the ability to know, understand and respect your partners strength rather than harping on their areas of opportunity (weakness) constantly pointing them out laced with derogatory statements that are put downs. Constructive channeling to help one improve in those areas goes a longer way in creating a stronger bond and solidify your relationship, creates opportunity for each to recognize the sincerity of their mate.

Respecting another's opinion by taking the opportunity to hear them out completely helps you gain an understanding of the thought process as it reveals a deep part of their character. Channeling their beliefs and exposing insight to their fears. Ask questions to complete your understanding of their point of view. It allows for a deeper insight and can often remove conflict and intimidation, opening up you're understanding to some of their upbringing and experiences whether they be positive or negative with unhealed scares.

Relationships go deeper than just the surface of what is allowed to be seen. We must maintain an understanding that we don't understand 100 % about a person

because we are not with them 24/7. When negative situations occur the reaction was triggered by some sort of event that creates a respond usually caused by fear and not willing to experience that sort of trauma again. So, we must demonstrate patience, gently seek knowledge to gain a better understanding so they can work through it as difficult sometimes as it could be and successfully heal.

Impactful, devastating when your loss it and can't find it anymore.



It had to be significant because your desire to be there kept on returning. Remember and understand why, realize it had to be significant because it didn't just happen to you, it was also experienced by your partner. It was much deeper than surface it was impactful to you both to become joint heirs in its creation. Couples who have longevity in their relationship continue to see, cherish, guard and protect, and build on it. Throughout the many roads traveled within a relationship good times and hardships this area remains the focal point of stainability, because there is a level of trust, and dependability allowing you push in the clutch for an even smoother ride up road because you see and understand the performance you are gaining, and fear is in the rear-view mirror getting smaller and smaller. Now you are truly understanding the terrain that is found and seen within the windshield providing a bigger picture of the opportunity on the journey ahead. Your starting to understand the performance and the dependability based on success of something that was built right, serviced and well maintained and not just put together for the flash affect that fades away because it lacks the sustainable components necessary performance. You now understand you have a dependable classic and every time you turn the key it switches on and hums in harmony. All cylinders perform in maximum capacity as you pass by those who are on the side of the road with their hoods up and hazard lights flashing.

As I write this, I can appreciate my wife more because I'm continuing to recognize her efforts to maintain a good stable performance with in the relationship. When we first talked about marriage her statement was "I don't want be head, I want to be the neck that turn the head." That was a precise statement with a lot of meaning and understanding. My understanding came this way, the Word of God reflects "Philippians 3:14 KJV press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. " Which also is further described within the 3rd chapter of Philippians as you study, reflecting back to the earlier passage for Jeremiah 29:11. When I press towards the mark I focused on that which God has shown me and my wife being part of me (an the two shall become one).

As God reveals to her (yes God communicates with our mates without consulting you so their input holds significant weight and that works both ways because they represent wise counsel, not stereotypical roles created by man). So, when we are focused on the mark, the other covers them, their back and their right and left sides as well, protecting them from impending danger or distractions that can knock them off their intended course delaying their destination arrival. The Word of God teaches us "In all thy getting, get an understanding." We fail miserably because we fail to set aside time to study the Word of God which is are manual for living. We also deepen that failure because we lack in prayer time, which is essential communication with our creator, which was afford to us by the sacrifice of Himself made by Jesus Christ. We further error because we have such a microwavable mindset of quick and fast expectations that when we pray, we do savory the conversation or wait for the response in our prayer time as though we are having a two-way conversation. Allowing the Holy Spirit to speak back to us revealing the truths and instructions that we need. If we are over talking and impatient, how can we hear the still soft voice as the Spirit speaks to us.

Another area of opportunity is how we define balance within our relationships and partnership. This understanding goes a long way in driving toward a successful and relationship avoiding major within harmonious any tension the relationship. Understanding yourself allows you know when you are drifting out of alignment with the harmony created but understanding and following the principles set forth by God. Any sort of unbalance can create undesirables' effects within your relationship. We must realize responses are triggered by that which we do or do not do within our daily relationship generated by expectations know or unknown. So we must always remain aware of reactions and responses. They represent the cause and effects of any situations or circumstances. So be present and be patient in your relationships or run the risk of losing them. Don't get too comfortable because you tend to take things for granted and get caught off guard in your expectations.

Having a selfish nature is the quickest way in which to destroy a relationship, it cannot be just your way. We have to incorporate the one principle in the Bible and that Jesus taught: Luke 6:31 KJV And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise. Treat everyone as you yourself would like to be treated. It will always put you far ahead before any conflict and confusion. You have learned to put yourself in the other person place.




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
