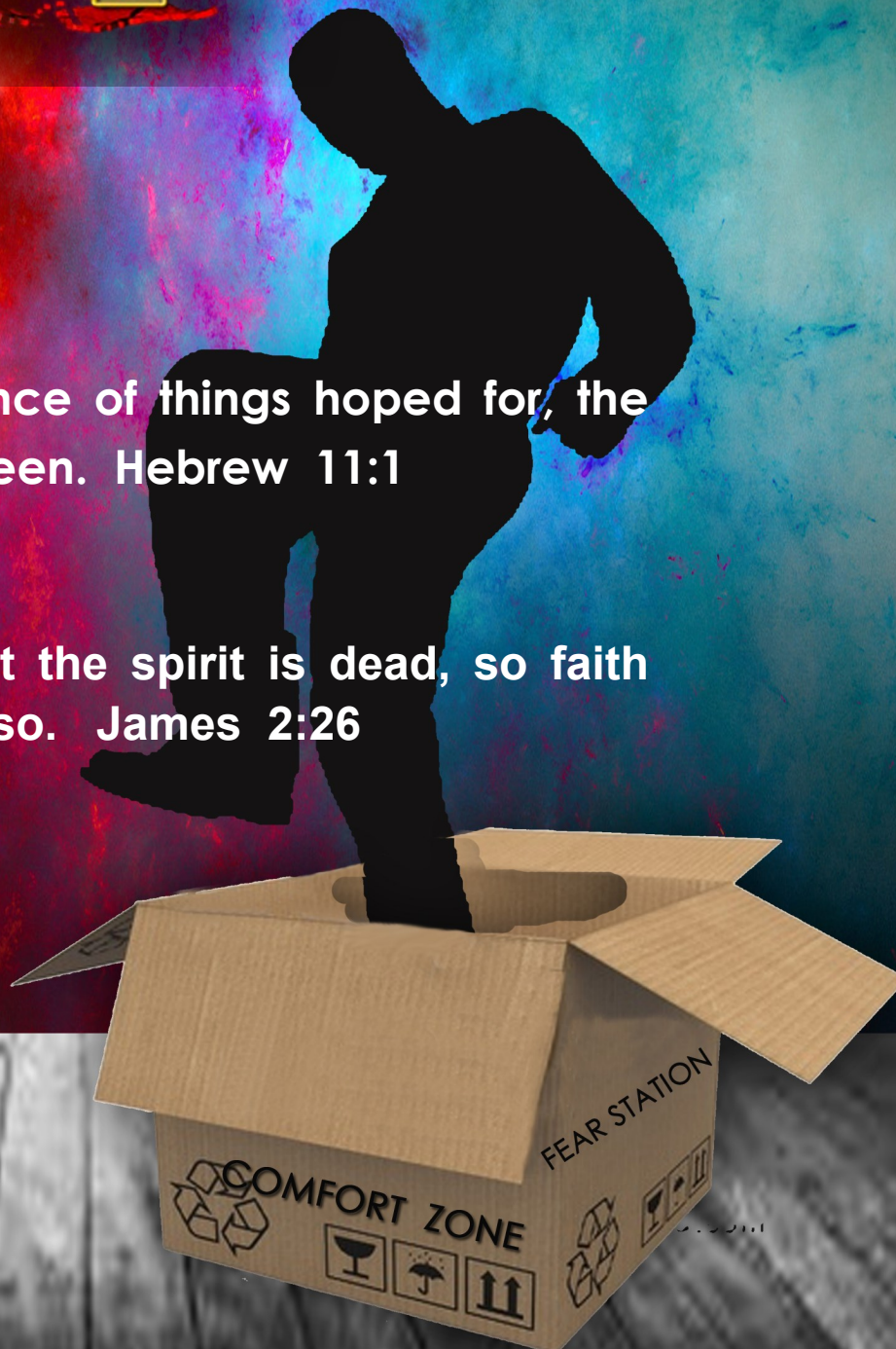

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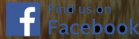

There was a scene from the movie "The Untouchables" I remember so well. Sean Connery portrayed "Malone" a Chicago police officer who was working with Elliot Ness on arresting Al Capone, the head of the crime organization "The Mob" in the early 1900's. Malone is attacked by one of Capone's associates, and he's bleeding profusely and near death when he's discovered by Ness. He has information pertinent to the investigation, and in his dying breath; he grabs Ness and asks him **"What are you prepared to do?"**

In the above scriptures, I believe we are all being asked the same question. God has set before us two ways of living. We can live in the blessing, or we can live under the curse. Then God says, you choose. So, what do you prepare to do to have God's best.

There are two (2) questions that we will be looking at concerning this statement.

The Cost Question: Are you willing to pay the price?

Even though we see all the promises and blessings in the Word of God, they will only be obtained by faith.

Mark 11:22-23(Kings James Version)

²² "And Jesus answering saith unto them, have faith in God.

²³ For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, what things so ever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them".

Hebrews 11:6 (Kings James Version)

"But without faith it's impossible to please God; for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him".

The Apostle Paul describes faith as a "fight" Why?

Romans 10:17 "So then, faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God."

And that's where the Cost Questions comes to fruition:

Are you willing to pay the price to seek the Lord in His Word?

Your mind hates the presence of God, so when you want to study God's word it will bombard you with everything to distract you. Therefore, Paul encourages us to "buffet" our body or putting it under subjection; until the spirit is king, the soul is the servant, and the body is the slave.

Scripture Reference: 1 Thessalonians 5:23 "And the very God of peace sanctify you whole, and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ".

Every successful person whether on television, movies, or sports had to pay the price to achieve success in their chosen field of influence. This brings us to the second part of the Cost Question.

Are you willing to withstand criticism as you pursue God's best in your life?

Scripture Reference: Psalm 118:6 "The Lord is on my side, I will not fear. What can man do unto me?"

The great author and poet Ralph Waldo Emerson made this statement:

"Whatever course you decide on, there is always someone to tell you that you are wrong.

There are always difficulties arising which tempt you to believe that your critics are right.

To map out a course of action and follow it to an end requires courage."

In the book of Genesis, during great wickedness in the land, to the degree that God was going to destroy all mankind, there was one man who found grace in the eyes of the Lord. That man was Noah, and the Lord instructed him to build an ark for the earth would soon be covered in water. Noah started to build this structure as the Lord commanded him. There's been no rain of this kind ever seen on earth. So, imagine the naysayers telling Noah that what he was doing was unnecessary. The rain did come seven days later, and his family, two animals of every kind were saved.

There is evil happening in this generation like we've never seen before, and I believe God is raising up a generation of "Noah's" who will go to the hedges and highways to tell men and women to run to the "ark of safety" which is found in a relationship with Jesus Christ.

The young man received Jesus as his savior at the young age of 8 years old. Preached his first sermon at the age of ten years old, years later along with his wife they began their ministry. The membership grew to 300, and in a bold move one Sunday, the young pastor declared that there would a changed in the ministry directions and teachings. This caused a major spilt in the church, and 277 people walked out that day leaving only 23 members. Determined not to be moved the young man continued ministering the Word of God despite the criticism he received from many - to the point the young man was handcuffed and arrested in his own pulpit during a Sunday morning worship service.

The ministry grew at an incredible rate, soon the ministry had two locations in Houston, and to date that number of locations has increased to six. All because this man I.V Hilliard refused to allow anyone else's opinion to become the final authority in his life.

This is the same attitude we all must have. The abundant life is available to all of us. The Word of God declares in **Jeremiah 29:11** that God's plans for us are to prosper and not bring evil upon us. So, knowing this should propel us to think differently, to believe for that which seems impossible. And not be deterred by the critics that are around us. Never let someone's objection to your taking God at His word be the deciding factor in your life.

Moses, the man who brought the children of Israel out of years of bondage faced constant criticism from the same people who thanked him for delivering them.

"Your success in life is determined by what you are willing to ignore".

Faith

What is Faith? Why do you believe? These are a couple of questions that are asked. But in order to have faith, you first have to repent. Faith and repentance are inseparable. In Acts 20:21 **“Testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.** (KJV) In other words, Paul was saying he has had one message for Jews and Gentiles alike- the necessity of turning from sin to God through faith in Jesus for what He has done on the cross. If we just repent of sin and fail to exercise our faith in God for reconciliation, then we will end in failure.

The meaning of the word Faith

The root word from which we get **faith**, the noun is PISTIS, and **believe**, the verb is PISTUEO.

FAITH - PISTIS means faith, belief, firm persuasion, assurance, faithfulness.

BELIEVE - PISTUEO means to trust in and rely upon, commit to the charge of, and confide in.

In other words when we grab hold of God’s resources and become obedient to what He has told us to do and put aside all self-interest and relying on our own self, trust God completely. We have to surrender our whole being in dependence upon Him. We have to trust and rely upon Him for all things. Proverbs 28:26 says that **“He that trusts in his own heart is a fool”** but yet we continue to make fools of ourselves by not **“Trust in God with all your heart and lean not to your own understanding”** Proverbs 3:5 for it’s a shame that even the demons believe. James 2:19 says **“You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!”** It is important to have faith, because **it is impossible to be saved without faith and without faith it is impossible to please God.** -Hebrews 11:6.

Our whole salvation is centered around faith. **“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, and the evidence of things not seen”** Hebrews 11:1. We have to believe in that which we cannot see. 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We Walk By Faith, Not by sight

From every angle, faith has been explain and displayed. We have taken faith apart and put it back together. Although many make altar calls to live by faith, preach faith and encouraged people to step out on faith, we first must realize that faith must be present. You can't tell a person without feet to stand flat footed or to put their feet in their shoes and stand upright. That would be impossible to do, right? Exactly.

So here in the second epistle of the Apostle Paul's letter to the Corinthians, he makes a vital statement, he says, "We walk by faith, not by sight", 5:7. He made this statement because there were those who were Christians that didn't quit understand. The Apostle Paul had taught the Romans that Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God, but the Corinthians got the words, We walk by faith, not by sight." What a difference? Were these people around when he taught the Romans? Did they really understand walking by faith; something that can't be seen opposed to something we rely on to see? Hmmm, something to think about.

When Paul said, "Walk by faith", what he was actually saying was that we move, we operate not based on what we see. We move based on the Word of God which is Spirit, which can't be seen. The written word is seen, but the WORD itself is the Son of God whom no one seen. Paul is saying, stop looking at things. Stop relying on your physical eyesight to get things done. Faith is your spiritual eyesight. Faith is your spiritual hands. Faith is the actual movement that is unrestricted, but is most powerful when it is understood and used.

How do we walk by faith? We take God at His word. We believe the works of God. We do what God says do and not ask how. Our natural mind wants to know how we will do it, yet, it will never understand the spirit. Back in the second chapter of the second epistle of Corinthians the Apostle Paul stated, "But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned", (2:14). The Word of God and our Spirit should become one – like a team. The word lead and our spirit follow. When we walk by faith, there is no questioning, be believe and do. Nike says it best, "*Just do it!*"

Take me out of the box the limitation of your life experience and step out on Faith of who I Am.

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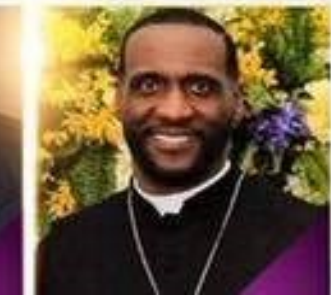

Every so often, a segment of a sermon comes to mind pertaining to the subject of bondage—or *at least that is what I perceived as the focus of the message*—I heard one evening as a member of a Brownsville ministry located in Brooklyn, NY. I'll never forget one of the statements our guest speaker made. I cannot remember his name, but he made such a positive impact upon me. With robust energy in his delivery, in a seasoned manner, while full fledge in his message, he said: *The last time I saw something with two heads, it killed itself!* Even now, I laugh—and I heard this message about 20 years ago. *God bless him!* However, the focal point of my article is far from a laughing matter. Its direction has been inspired by another aspect of this minister's message that resonated with me during the years. I hope it will speak truth to you, too, and to those who desire help from past and present forms of bondage—whether emotional or spiritual. I hope this article helps you to face what may be or seem to be overwhelming and close to unbearable. It is my anticipation that this message will empower you to increasingly trust in God by demonstrating Holy Ghost boldness in times of struggle and adversity.

John 15:18-20 King James Version (KJV)

¹⁸If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you.

¹⁹If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

²⁰Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.

Needless to share, trials and tribulation do not discriminate. Whether you are a believer or not, wealthy or poor, and skin color does not matter, hardship finds a way to knock on your door, and then say *Hello!* It will then attempt to walk in—and succeed, and attempt to set up residency. Sometimes such experiences stay for long lengths of time; seemingly unending. You seek relief; desiring help from your inner circle; however, you may have learned the hard way that those you seek help from need help themselves, or that their help is not enough. Perhaps your story is that when you believe you are rising out of one dilemma, another one attempts to hold you back. Over and over again, it seems it is one thing after another. You may have asked, *How did I get here? What happened? Why can't I break free!*

²⁵And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

²⁶And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.

As I shared above, during an evening at service, a guest minister spoke, in part, about the plight of captured elephants. *Yes, elephants.* He gave a descriptive account of how hunters (to put it lightly), violated these creatures of the wild by using the most heinous techniques. My personal research confirms that upon capture, such villainous individuals would beat them mercilessly, and remove their tusks. Elephant predators used chains, whips, and electric rods to subdue them; even to the point of inflicting pain upon its genitalia. *Too graphic, too much?* Imagine living it. *On a human perspective, the end result of dying in sin is worse. We need God.*

Now back to the messenger: Our guest minister described a captured elephant's desire to move beyond a small circumference. Over and over again, this majestic creature would stop because it was bound at its feet. *After a while, its torturers took off the restraints that had it bound.* The elephant, being detained and conditioned for so long, would walk a few feet, and then stop, just to turn around, and return to its post. As this man of God spoke, I began to visualize and empathize with this elephant; seeing it focused upon the entrance of a warehouse structure that was right before it; seeing the light of day; walking towards the door, but stopping after taking a few steps. The elephant, without being bound, was now conditioned to remain within its boxed area—*the room*. It was denied the privilege of going

beyond its post—*no longer by the physical restraints—but now by its mind*. Looking at the entraDay after day, week after week, month after month...*year after year*, the elephant would walk nceway, and in spite of its enormous size and strength, although seeing the light of day, the elephant could not cognitively accept or realize it had the power to flee.

to the parameter of its confinement, slow down, come to a stop, and then turn around back to its post. As we know, an elephant's natural habitat is the wilderness with others of its kind. However, in captivity, the elephant was placed inside a room or an outside area, to later serve as a spectacle for humans. The accounts above are real; such horrendous acts actually happened; pray past tense, to elephants in present day (ABC7 I-Team, 1995). *[Note: After writing this article, on its day, I learned that August 12 was designated World Elephant Day, with the focus of ending illegal ivory trafficking (theguardian.com, 2017). That's God.]*

As it pertains to us, the question is: *What can we equate to the heinous acts described above?* Bullying, domestic violence, defamation of character, sexual abuse, to name a few. The outcomes can manifest feelings of isolation, despair, depression, hopelessness, and the worse of all outcomes, suicide—both physical and spiritual. It is my prayer that anyone who carries such burdens will search for someone to talk to, and not carry such burden alone. It is vital to know that there are programs and people out there who desire to help. If this applies to you or someone you know, *please talk to someone. Again, don't carry this burden alone—you do not have to.*

Learning to trust in God by stepping out in faith can help us to get out of the box. Here, the box represents the same for nonbelievers and believers alike who have been deceived into thinking there is no way out from a dilemma; thereby harboring a sense of being forsaken, lost. *There is a remedy:* The box can become weakened by placing faith in God, or by rekindling and strengthening faith in God. On the contrary, by not realizing the power that is in our midst (as in the example of a conditioned elephant), we would not be fully exercising our spiritual power; hence, the box that could potentially contain us—that traps us—becomes stronger.

The Word of God only has power if activated. The bible is life's application. God's Word, supported by healthy fellowship with others can help alleviate our burden. If we do not have someone close, or an associate that we can reach out to, there are other options. We have the ability to reach out to a workforce center, a clinic, or go online to seek out information on 24/7 call centers that will enable us to speak anonymously. We can break free from the box. Seek help; know that we have the power to reach out. We have the power to step out in faith and get out of the box. Everyone's situation is personal and unique, but be sure that there is

someone beyond the box that can identify with what we are going through. Choose to live! Choose to succeed. *Reach out of the box!*

Perhaps you are doing all that you know how to do in Christ Jesus. You've prayed, fasted, attended inspirational services and meetings; yet it appears that your situation is not changing for the better. Maybe getting out of your box requires you to take a different approach in addition to what you are doing. Not to trivialize anyone's situation, but maybe, *just maybe*, it requires you to not open a text, or pick up the phone, from someone who continues to deposit their troubles into you. Perhaps it requires you to stop reading garbage on your social network accounts. Perhaps your box continues to contain you based upon a situation that is not so obvious. Seeking out professional assistance to share what you are going through may shed additional light into your situation that may assist you on your way to a healthy outcome.

On a personal note, I remember working in an environment where I could see one of my coworkers walk in every morning, alongside of a see-through curtained glass partition that separated my workspace from the corridor. My co-worker would cut the corner to enter where two other co-workers and I were located, and then, upon stepping one foot and then the other in the room, let out a loud and long sigh of distress, and then start sharing about what she experienced that did not go well—from her boyfriend on down—for long periods of time. Although she sat behind us and our backs faced her, she was not hindered. We spoke to help her as friendly co-workers would; however, it was as though she would rather deal with the situation that made her miserable. What made this evident? She shrugged off advice. This situation transpired for months. It took a while before I realized how her communications began to negatively impact me.

I was much younger then, and did not think much of it; however, I eventually realized how hearing someone's daily complaints could bring me into a state of anxiety resulting in tension headaches. Simultaneous to what I was going through, I knew someone in my inner circle that was experiencing a similar situation. What I realized was that we both were dealing with unhealthy encounters that we had to acknowledge and address to overcome.

One day I finally spoke with my co-worker, and shared with her how I was feeling, and how I was affected by the daily conversations about her personal life. I was sure to let her know that I empathized with her, but that if she felt she was in a toxic relationship, the best recourse was to do something about it and not tolerate it. She apologized. The very next business day, while working, I noticed her, as usual, walking down the corridor while I sat at my desk adjacent to the curtained glass partition. When she cut the corner, she gave me a look from the corner of

her eye as she passed, and quietly sat down. *You may giggle at this point, that's alright!* Trust me, I know I can share with confidence that I felt like I had the victory! *YEAH!* The constant distractions and stories were over. My situation improved drastically, headaches, anxiety were eventually gone! *(To share, I don't know what happened to her boyfriend, but I have to admit, I was glad I did not have to hear about it as much.)* Furthermore, I'm sure that my other fellow co-workers felt the same, but did not speak up.

The takeaway: You just can't always talk about problems; you have to acknowledge them, and then work them out. If you find yourself experiencing anxiety and stress and do not know why, look at your routine; see if there may be contributing factors; examine the moments that you are hit the hardest. In a healthy manner, try your best to address it; if not alone, with someone close to you that you trust. If necessary, seek professional assistance; i.e., 24/7 hotlines, human resources, your primary physician, community groups—*somebody if you do not want to or cannot do it alone.*

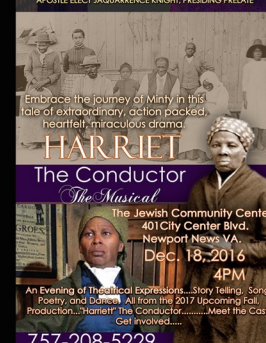
Dear Reader: *Do your best to not focus upon the negatives that you cannot control, and learn to accentuate the positives. If you cannot dismiss or eliminate your negatives, learn ways to look at how you can learn from them. Perhaps that might help relieve you from the box you may feel you are in. Don't be that elephant who did not know it was loosed from its chain of bondage because of the lack of focus upon a solution. Think about how you can succeed not only because you would like to, but also because you know deep down inside you can. Right here, right now, try to acknowledge what is trying to keep you in the box, and claim that the bondage hindering you is a defeated foe. Speak its demise into existence. Speak your desired positives into existence, and know that you have the potential to work out a solution!* Do not give up or give in. On a spiritual level, claim you are a child of God. *You are a King's kid!*

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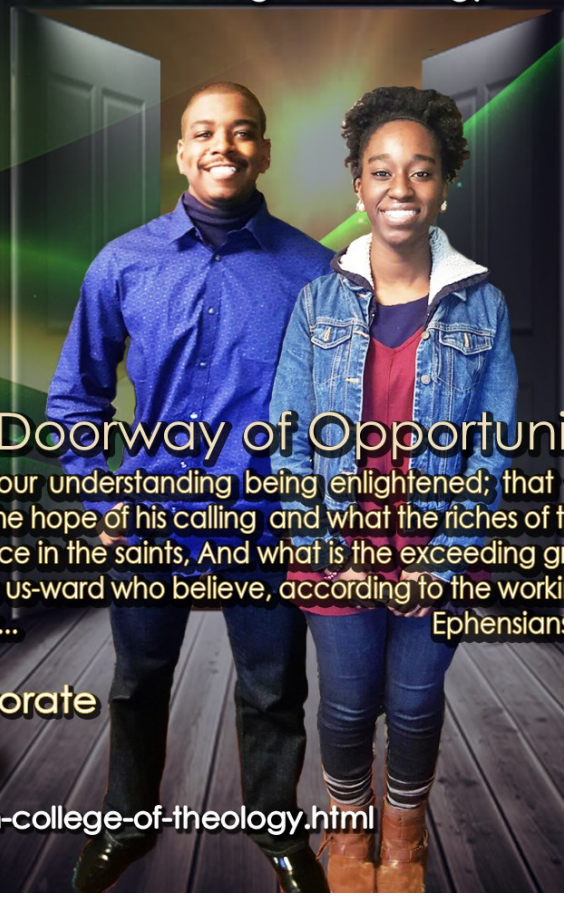
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“Maneuvering In the Dark”

I went through 10 hours of surgery, received 16 pints of blood, shot 16 times with morphine - I'm telling you what God will do for you. God had me going through this process for me to utilize the faith that God has giving me to believe to put my trust totally in him that was so important. After all I went through; I then had to have open heart surgery because there was a hole in the heart, shortness of breath; a pulmonary artery condition which resulted in my walking being limited. I'm telling you about you putting your faith into action if you had to deal with carbon monoxide in your body. I am a living witness that God can do the miraculous when your blood pressure is 200 over 198. Who will believe the report of the Lord? 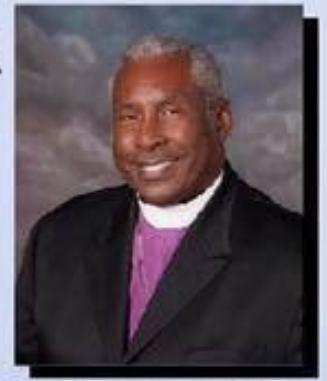

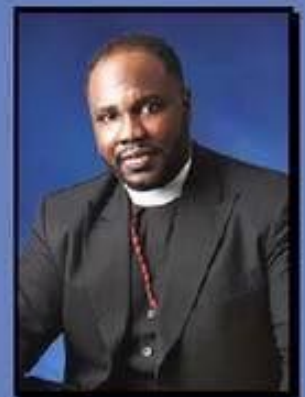

For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead.)

So many today (Western World) seek the blessing without true faith (that follows our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ). Our faith, life and love to God is supposed to be genuine, authentic and covenant like a marriage. A holy marriage is genuine and our relationship must have that kind of genuine faith and faithfulness! So why do we lack the fruitfulness of the marriage?

It is faith in Jesus Christ who paid it all with the shedding of His blood on the cross. That's GRACE (UNMERITED FAVOR. We don't deserve it, nor did we earn it according to Ephesians 2:8-9). Our Christian life is a life of METAMORPHOSIS-A marked change in appearance, character, or condition that was done by the very work of God, the Holy Spirit which was poured down upon us according to Gal. 5: 1-11 and by the product of this work which is consistent with us being crucified with Christ! Gal. 2:20-21! Our old life is dead to sin (Romans 6) and alive to God which when you and I clothe ourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ (Col. 3:12, Rom. 13:14), we are spiritually prepared to live out this Christian life as a Christian walking in the Spirit, and loving others as Christ has loved us.

(John 13:34 ESV A new commandment

I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.)

It's not hard when we pick up our cross daily and learning to dye to self (Matt. 16:24; Lk. 9:23; Lk. 14:27). What it really comes down to is commitment to being married to Christ. The Commitment to God's marriage covenant. It's not about the benefits here on earth, but for the Heavenly benefits that will take us into eternity (Col. 3:1-4, Esv)

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.)

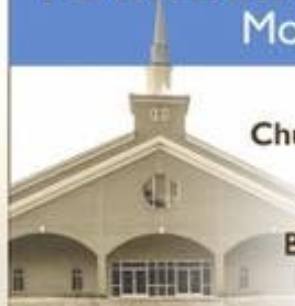
