*"The effectual, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" James 5:16 (Kings James Version).*

*"All men should pray, and not faint" Luke 18:1 (Kings James Version).*

**The Preacher has taught on the Word of God from the bottom of their heart, and now they're asking for those who need prayer for healing, or deliverance, or whatever the need is in their lives to come, and let them and their staff agree with them in prayer.**

**People come from all sides of the auditorium, and the front is soon filled with people, some are weeping, and some are on their knees in deep prayer. The only difference is most of those in front are women. How many have seen this numerous times?**

**The men are sitting down, hands folded together, staring blank into space. The world is full of men who stare, unfeeling now, they know they need prayer, but again the pride that many carry keep them locked out from receiving what they need.**

**The Prison population is full of men, who refuse to ask for help to deal with the anger, or the feeling of hopelessness they hide behind the phrase "I'm alright".**

**I recall a scene that just happened recently that brings relevance to this: I work as a security officer, and my shift is from 7pm till 7am the next day. On this day, there was thunderstorm, and the wind was blowing and the rain was coming down in buckets.**

**Part of my duties is to patrol the entire building, including the outside. Because of the weather conditions I couldn't do it, but I can visually see whether there was anything happening out of the ordinary. I look out and**



across the street, I saw five men, sleeping in the street, in the middle of this storm, and I saw about eight more grown men on the other side sleeping, some had tons of blankets covering them, others had sleeping bags, and one slept in a carton. I said to myself: "Why can't they go somewhere and get shelter from this rain", and then I looked at the church, and saw almost the exact same thing.

Men, come to the house of God, dressed to impress, know how to deflect the conversation to what they are dealing with, to "I'm blessed". They sit through the worship portion, and watch as the women who are very vocal, are not ashamed to express their thankfulness to the Lord.

Men, we must break the stigma, that we don't need any help. That God, our Heavenly Father has made it available to come before His throne of grace, and seek His help in the time of need.

But, there are people in our church, who are also there for us, not in judgment, but to allow us to open those places we reserve to keep locked inside of us.

Real freedom is having the ability to come before another brother, or even a sister, and say "Will you pray for me", and still know that you are a man!!

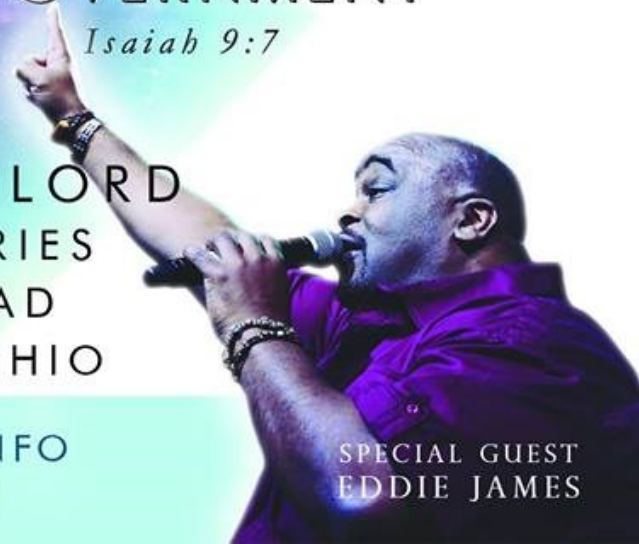

# Impact

The decisions that we make impact the effectiveness of our destiny. We can delay or destroy the outcome when we lead with or emotions rather than sound wisdom.

The greatest challenges are faced when harmony and unity are the objective because they yield the greatest dividends which provides the biggest and lasting results for the greatest strength to opposition. It's called being on one according. Like mindedness. Prime example in the upper room when the Holy Ghost fell upon the 120 occupants and they received power from on high. The Holy Ghost which is the keeping power that dwells and provides advancement for the believer as well as comfort and guidance during the advancement of Gods purpose in the earth. The Holy Ghost manifests his power through the anointing that rest upon the believer who operates in obedience to the will of God. For the Bible says in Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days saith God "I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh: and your son's and daughters shall prophesy and your young men shall see visions and your old men shall dream dreams. And on my servants and my hand maidens I will pour out in those day my spirit and they shall prophesy. I will shew wonders in heaven above and signs in the earth beneath. blood. and fire and vapour of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness and the moon into blood before that great and notable day of the Lord come.

One of the most important things is to pay attention and take note to what is taking place. Warning comes before destruction it's getting to point of past time for cry loud and spare not. We cannot take a position of being lacks in the face of impending danger. Where are the street corner preacher and the testimonies of the saints that impacted those who are lost to regain their sight of the Almighty God because we as his children were effected in removing the blinder that blocked their vision. Where are the wailing women the laboured at the alter with prayer and supplication for the lost. Where are the laborers the worked the field to yield the harvest. We have to be delinquent about the work of the field. Every time you come to church alone you have failed to harvest. We see women tired of bad relationships or doing without. We see men beat down verbally because they struggle trying to do right but is never appreciated. We have homeless people on the street without anything to eat. Our government, police department, senate, state, president, etc., can't do it. We want to point fingers at those on disability, public assistance, SSI etc., but no one is trying to help. There are people looking for jobs – any kind of job but no one wants to help them. Too many people have a secure job and don't even consider trying to get someone a job in a office or in the store. I know I have been there. I have helped many people in different ways to get on their feet and when it came to me, knowing I was out of a job, they didn't even think about me. They went and got their girlfriend a job that

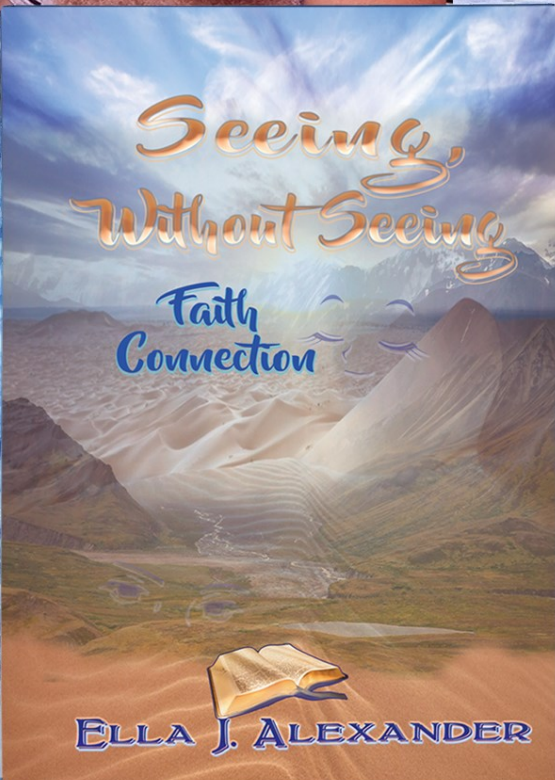

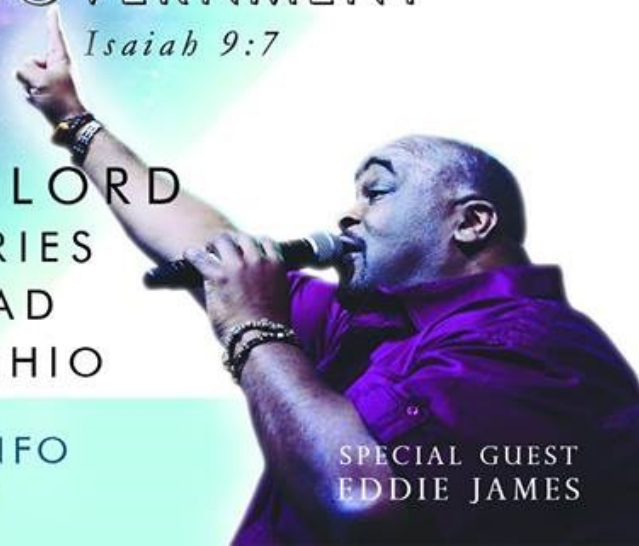

It is such a blessing to learn to trust in Jesus, our Lord and Savior. If you have not as yet, I hope you will learn this soon for yourself. The peace that overflows into the heart upon accepting Him as personal Lord and Savior can be marvelous. It can also entail the sting of reality that sets in on how dreadful being lost in sin could have been if it had not been for Him who is on our side. Being saved is not to be taken lightly; it is a gift—a gift freely given by God's only begotten Son, Jesus.

<sup>8</sup> For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

<sup>9</sup> Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Acceptance of Jesus does not have to be an overly emotional experience, although it can be. You do not have to fall out; speak in tongues, run around the church. Receiving Jesus as your personal Lord and Savior can occur as quietly as sitting in your home, knowing that He's speaking to you; calling you. He is love. During such an experience, you will have come to terms that He truly cares for you. It is as simple as acknowledging the following: *Lord Jesus, I confess that I am a sinner; I repent of my sins. I know there is no other way that I can be saved. You died and rose again that I may have the gift of everlasting life. You are the Son of the Living God. I have accepted you as my Lord and Savior. Please have your way in my life; lead me and guide me according to your divine will.*

The more you learn to trust in Jesus, the more you will recognize the power and the unction of the blessed trinity: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost. The three are One. You cannot accept one without the other; not in the Christian faith.

<sup>21</sup> For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth *them*; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.

Many will expound upon the Word; however, it is important for you to know the Word for yourself. It is important to ask The Most High God in the name of His Son Jesus for direction in reading and digesting His Word. *It is also important to ask Him for direction as to where you should be fed.* Seek a ministry that is bible-based. You would think that should be evident, but it is not.

There are ministries that speak from the Word of God, but divert much of their effort upon matters that have little to do with saving souls. An example: I have engaged with a ministry where one of the senior leaders of the ministry took great joy in sharing gory details of a favorite TV show. I felt I had to cleanse my mind from the negative connotations that spewed during the delivery process in order to receive the intended message. Another example: A ministry that I attended frequently interjected political commentaries as part of the sermon. At times it was interesting, but as an ongoing experience, frankly, it became a bit annoying (especially when the prophetic interjections did not come to pass). Eventually, I was left a bit hungry for the unadulterated knowledge and wisdom of God. Of course, I study independently, but I also look forward to fellowship as well as hearing the unadulterated Word expounded from the pulpit—and not political lop-sided commentaries. During one of these politically-charged messages, one of the congregants desired to interject by raising his hand; which was supposed to be acceptable, but was instructed to wait until later. Such type of encounters, I believe, can quench the Holy Spirit and move of God upon the life of a believer.

## **2 Timothy 2:15 King James Version (KJV)**

<sup>15</sup> Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Understand that there are those who will desire for you to become a member of their ministry, and rightfully so. There are members who should be positioned to receive newcomers. However, it is important during the process of membership that you become grounded in your relationship *with Jesus, the Christ, first in order for you to have a personal and right relationship with Him.* Bible class should be set in place upon your acceptance. If not, seek out how the ministry you have under consideration reinforces what is being expounded upon during Sunday service. Also, learn the culture of the ministry; their mission statement is important. Overall, there should be resources in place that should assist with one's spiritual growth.

**Dear Reader:** *Do not cut yourself short, or the ministry, for that matter! Please do not say to yourself, I'm working things out first before I go to church. God is a Right Now God! He can meet you where you are—don't wait! Waiting may be too late.*

Years ago, I was feeling deeply troubled about a situation. I felt so heavy—I knew I had to shake it off. Then a thought came to mind about a ministry that I could attend without waiting for Sunday. I thought *Yes! I need fellowship today. I'll go there now!* By the end of the service, my spirit was so uplifted to the point that I continued to attend. Mind you, I had known, respected, and admired the leader of this ministry for well over a decade. Soon thereafter, I joined the ministry. However, there was something that my spirit needed that was missing—*Do this in Remembrance of Me*—that's what was missing—*Holy Communion.*



Holy Communion was not part of the ministerial order. Furthermore, during the high holy days of the year, Jesus was not at the forefront of the messages. Passover, while definitely a Christian experience, was at the forefront; but there was no or little reflection upon Jesus' birth or resurrection. It was at least three years before I left. During my attempt to say goodbye to my leader, I was told that I could worship where I felt led to go, while remaining in touch as a member. I was surprised at the suggestion; I thought that was a gracious response. To add, I loved my leader dearly, but I felt in my heart that eating regularly from more than one table on a regular basis would not be best for my spiritual growth (although I did take the permission under strong consideration). I left respectfully, and visited a few times to say hello.

Now you may ask, *Was that all—no Holy Communion?* There were other reasons; I believe it was my time to move. However, the reason pertaining to the aspect of ministry that accentuates Jesus as my personal Lord and Savior exceeded them all and is enough—*I desire a ministry that engulfs the Christian experience.* To add, I truly believe it was God's will for me to be there, but not as a final place to be permanently rooted and grounded. So yes, please know the culture of a ministry before joining—and learn whether it aligns to the will of God for your life. Also, be mindful that you can learn from every experience if you are teachable. Stay encouraged.

Listen to His voice; I've learned that He speaks to me softly; gently. Even after many years of being saved, *I am still learning to discern His voice*—I know you can or will too. My prayer for you in His name is this: That the Holy Spirit will rest, rule, and abide upon you and that He will keep you in His perfect peace; in His care. Take quiet moments to meditate on His goodness. He will direct your path. Seek to have a personal relationship with our Lord and our God.

# Anxiety Has a Cure

"... Do not worry or be anxious (*perpetually uneasy, distracted*), saying, 'What are we going to eat?' or 'What are we going to drink?' or 'What are we going to wear?' For the [*pagan*] Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; [but do not worry,] for your heavenly Father knows that you need them." Matthew 6:31-34 *Amplified Bible*

Really? Do you mean to say I do not need to allow my mind to dwell on making provisions for the basic necessities of life? I can't just chill and expect that a place for me and my family to live (shelter), or food, or medical care will just show up. And Lord knows I need a hairdo! What's Jesus really talking about - "do not worry?"

You and I have been cultured to making a living be our priority. Our parents impressed upon us to get an education so that we could hold down a job or operate a business so we could have all those things Jesus mentioned and when we don't have them or when they're threatened we get anxious because we fear homelessness and hunger. It's simply part of the human condition, that's why Jesus said, "Your Heavenly Father knows that you need them." (Read that part again).

Every responsible and resourceful mother (or father), knowing their child's needs and wants find ways to ensure they're taken care of. The child therefore has no concern about how rent, school fee or grocery bills will be paid; she simply exists in the knowing that when she gets hungry there is food and all she needs to do is ask for it.

That is why Jesus says we need to have the faith of a little child. Paul said, "But my God shall abundantly supply all your need according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19 Darby Translation. God is that resourceful and responsible parent.

I'd like to share something from a devotional I read today:

"When the people of Israel were in the desert on the way to the Promised Land, God gave them manna to eat. That was good. It sustained them for a while, but it wasn't permanent provision...Eventually, the manna stopped coming. The people had to move forward, and then God gave them quail. They were so excited. That fed them for a while, but it was also temporary. See, God gave the Israelites temporary provision on the way to the Promised Land where they



would have permanent provision. God could have sustained them with manna or quail, [but He had an even greater plan]."

Even though God gave us the obligation to "be fruitful and multiply" as we read in Genesis 1 that is secondary to His mandate to seek first the kingdom of God and all His righteousness and all these things - food, clothing, shelter and yes, money for your fabulous 'do', will be given. Just know that it is there, and ask for it. Then believe that you have received it. Get to truly know God, the Heavenly Father and you will see that He is real and He is not lying.

If you are a parent, you must know how upsetting it can be for your child to beg from the neighbors; and that's what we do when we ease God out and look to ourselves for provision. And how miserably we fail at it too, bringing on to ourselves all the effects of anxiety - high blood pressure, depression, arthritis, cancer, obesity, substance abuse, and the list goes on.

It is hard to "only trust Him" as we sing from our hymnals, but that's ultimately what God wants us to do. Allow Him to be the Loving, Provident Heavenly Father that He is. Tell Him multiple times a day that you want to get to know who He is so that you can put your faith in Him in every aspect of your life. He is interested in you and in building a rock solid relationship with you so that you will need to have no other god besides Him. Then the peace which transcends human understanding will keep your heart and mind free from anxiety.

This issue will begin a series on the benefits of different herbs in our dietary intake. While traditional medicine still has its place, natural products have proven immensely beneficial when it comes to health and wellness. This month we will focus on one of the oldest and best tasting home remedies----*Peppermint*. Peppermint is a flowering perennial that is indigenous to Europe and the Middle East. It will usually grow between 12-35 inches in height. It is a natural hybrid of spearmint and water mint.

Peppermint has been used in alternative medicine as a possibly effective aid in treating irritable bowel syndrome, breast feeding discomfort, heartburn, migraines, tension headache and to reduce spasms during endoscopy and colon exams. Other uses not proven with research have included dental plaque, bad breath, hot flashes, pain caused by shingles, itchy skin, toothaches, infections, and muscle pain. The herb has also been noted to have a calming effect on the body and a possible remedy to help soothe a nagging cough.

Other possible benefits for peppermint include: antispasmodic (abdominal pain, cramps), gas, aid digestion, and help with insomnia. Studies have shown that peppermint decreases the amount of time food spends in the stomach by stimulating the gastric lining. It may also relax the stomach muscles.

Herbal supplements should be purchased from a reliable source to minimize the risk of contamination. The parts commonly used are dried or fresh leaf and essential oil. Tea is the most common and best employed use of peppermint.

Have you ever noticed that some restaurants give their patrons peppermint candy after a multicourse meal? This is to aid digestion. Quality hotels also put peppermint candies on the pillow to promote a goodnight rest. So, if you are one who tend to toss those little peppermint candies to the side, you might want to give it a second thought.
