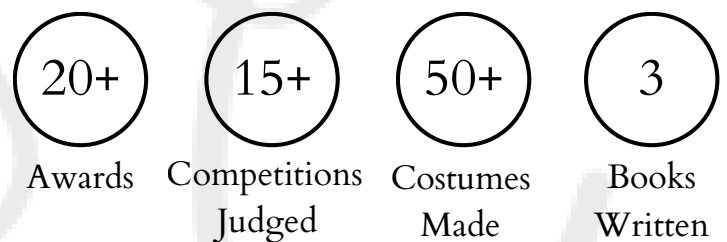

I have 5+ years of judging experience from local conventions to international qualifiers. On a judging panel, I am typically considered the "Jack of all Trades" type of cosplayer. I have judged local competitions to international qualifiers in Canada and the USA.

With no specific specialty, I practice and understands a vast number of techniques including:

- Foam work
- Leatherwork
- Embroidery
- Electronics and Programming
- Sculpting and Casting
- Thermoplastics
- Articulating pieces
- Painting
- Puppetry and Monster building
- 3D modeling and Printing
- Wig Styling
- Sewing
- Pattern making
- Skit Performances and Walk-ons

My favorite techniques from the above this are electronics, leatherworking and embroidery.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Cosplay Classes: Tandy Leather

In my city, Calgary Alberta, I teach a cosplay leather working class for beginner leatherworkers and cosplayers. To the right is one of my students and their first leather working build! I teach skills from picking leather, tooling, dying and painting, stitching and wet forming. My students work through a project based curriculum that gets them a finished product that they will wear and love!
