Care Coordination	The organized approach to managing and integrating all aspects of a resident's care. It ensures that medical, personal, and suppor services work together seamlessly to meet the resident's needs, improve their quality of life, and enhance their overall care experien	
ADL (Activities of Daily Living)	Include: dressing, grooming, bathing, continence care, positioning, eating, mobility, transferring.	
Nursing Assessment	A comprehensive evaluation of a resident's health and care needs conducted by a nurse. It includes reviewing and updating the resident's service plan to ensure it accurately reflects their current needs and provides appropriate care and support.	
Light Housekeeping	Includes tasks such as bedmaking, trash removal, and tidying walkways, typically completed within 15 minutes. It focuses on maintaining a clean and orderly living environment.	
Heavy Housekeeping	Involves more thorough cleaning tasks, such as dusting, wiping down surfaces, sweeping, and mopping, to ensure a deep clean and maintain a hygienic living environment. Includes 2 loads of laundry, additional loads available for additional fee.	
Summoning Device	A tool, often a wearable button, used by residents to alert staff within the home when they need assistance, ensuring a prompt response to their requests.	
Dietary Plan	A customized eating plan that incorporates resident preferences and ensures a well-balanced diet. It may include specialized diet tailored to specific health needs, which could incur an additional charge.	
Activities Plan	A tailored schedule of activities that considers resident preferences and aims to enrich the mind, body, and spirit, promoting overall we being and engagement.
