TITLE: Prohibition of Blackwater Potable Reuse

SUMMARY:

To protect drinking water within Volusia County, blackwater shall be prohibited from all potable water reuse and all aquifer injection. "Blackwater" means that part of domestic sewage carried off by toilets, urinals, and kitchen drains. "Potable water" means water that is satisfactory for human consumption, dermal contact, culinary purposes, or dishwashing as approved by the Florida Department of Health. Aquifer injection means pumping water into the aquifer and bypassing the earth's natural filtration process.

(Except as provided herein or as otherwise provided by separate amendment, provisions of the charter not shown are not amended. Further, words in ~~striketrough~~ type are deletions; words in underscored type are additions. The section number shall be revised as necessary to maintain sequence.)

Article II, Section 202 of the County Charter is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 202.4. Minimum Standards for Environmental Protection

Sec. 202.4.5 Prohibition of Blackwater Reuse.

Reuse of blackwater is prohibited from potable water reuse and aquifer injection within Volusia County including all cities and private water suppliers.

Definitions:

Blackwater means that part of domestic sewage carried off by toilets, urinals, and kitchen drains.

Potable water reuse means that water that is satisfactory for human consumption, dermal contact, culinary purposes, or dishwashing as approved by the Florida Department of Health.

Aquifer injection means pumping water into the Floridian Aquifer.
