



CBC Studies: Transliteration of Colossians 3:15-17 January 24, 2021

Col 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

Col 3:13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also *do* ye.

Col 3:14 And above all these things *put on* charity, which is the bond of perfectness.

(Vs 15) Immediately following observance of those verses
the strife of life can cease & troubles find terminus

We will be in one accord with the mind of The Lord
& life's pests that cause distress are easily destroyed

This mindset is a reward for our taking heed
to the apostle who penned those words sent from our KING

To peace we are called & therein compelled to stand
through the instrument God plays with His own Holy hand

His song is loud & it rings throughout the earth
from the body of our Living God; His redeemed eternal church

We can follow this call, without delay or suspense
we commence & never end -straightway, thanking Him

(Vs 16) As a matter of habit, we can now participate
as His Holy Word takes authority in our yielded state

There is much more Bible than we will ever need
It will uncloud our minds & clearly we will see

His grace will subdue & restrain the mighty curse
through the power & great depth of His Holy Word

In all of life's experiences we can resolve to attend
& follow His narrow path thru humanity as we pilgrim

Instructing, advising, tenderly reproving when at odds
with instruments, Psalms of old, & poems from the Spirit of God

Singing with Divine influence our stories we will tell
of He Who created all things -our God, Who saved us Himself

(Vs 17) No matter our vocation within His earthly reign
perform these magnificent duties with His character on display

Giving thanks to God as our Father acknowledging our unworthiness
& through Jesus Christ our Lord never, turning away again

Col 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and "spiritual songs" (***Poems that are sensitive to The Spirit of God***), singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Col 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.
