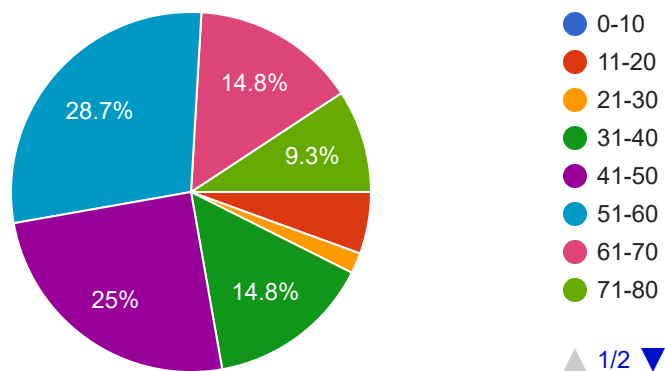

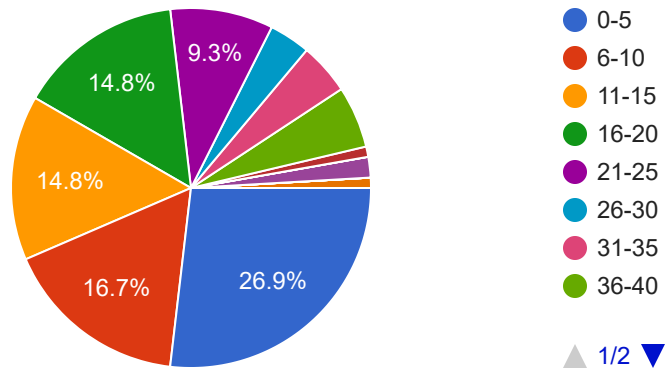

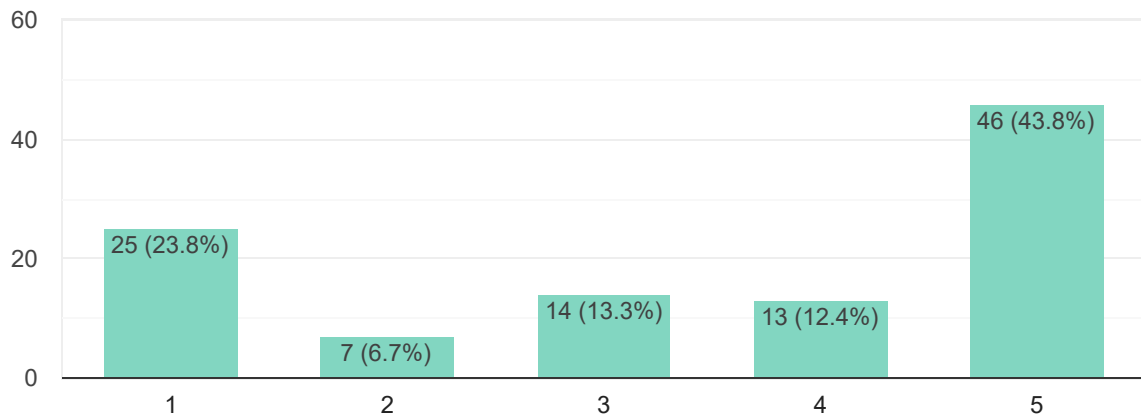

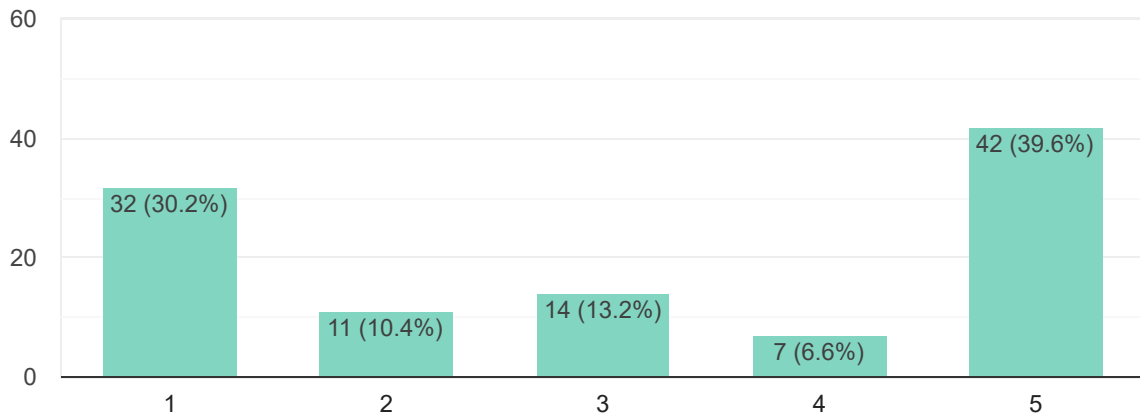

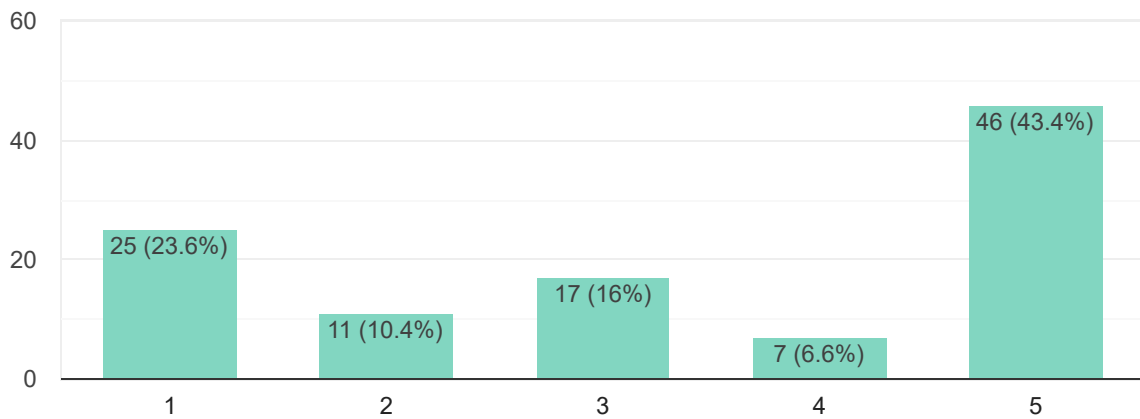

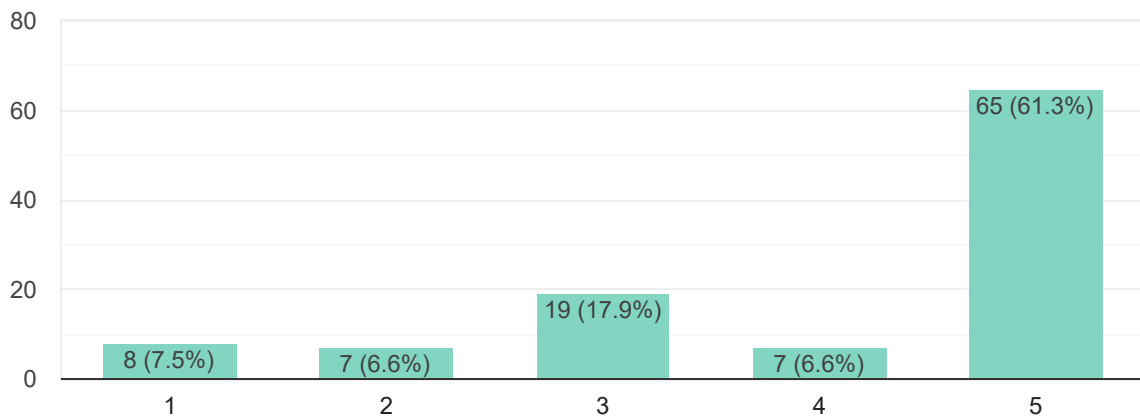

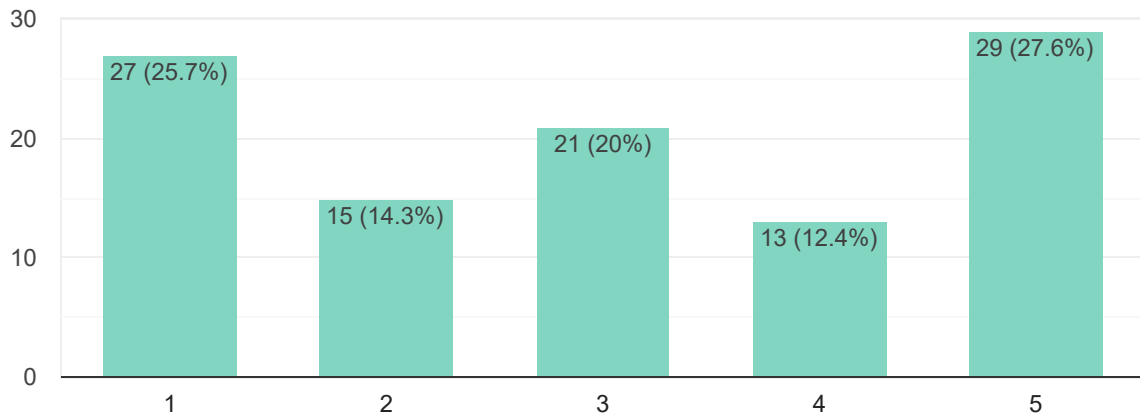

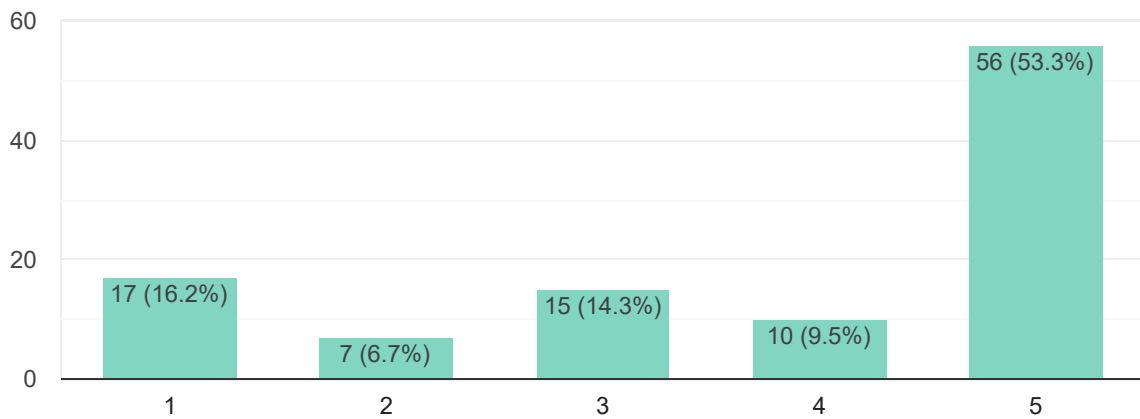

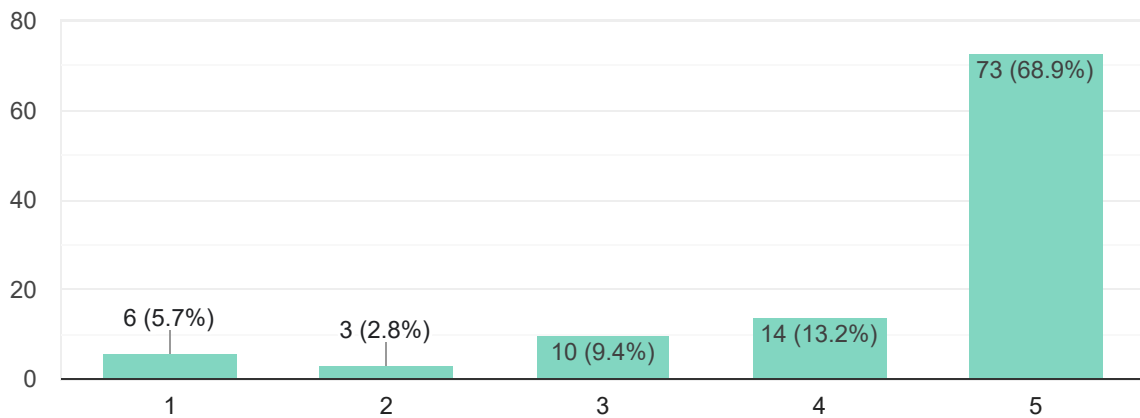

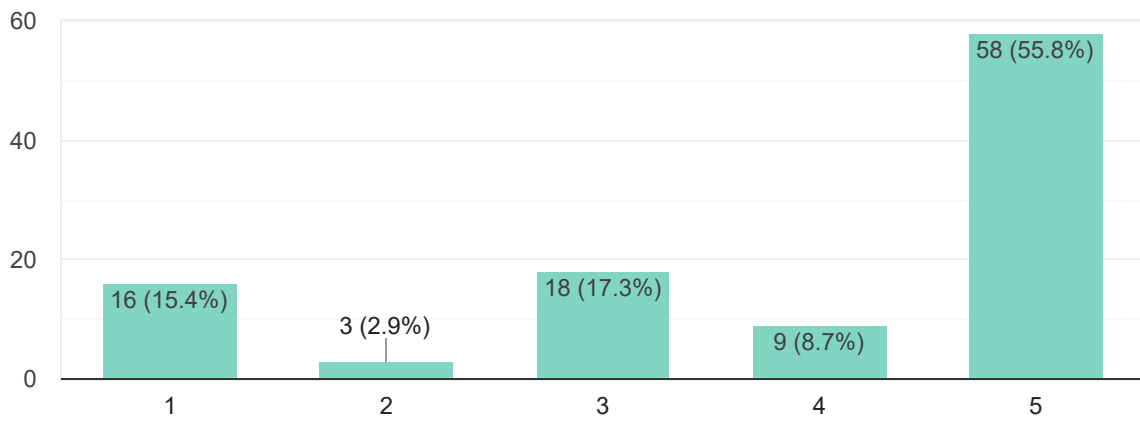

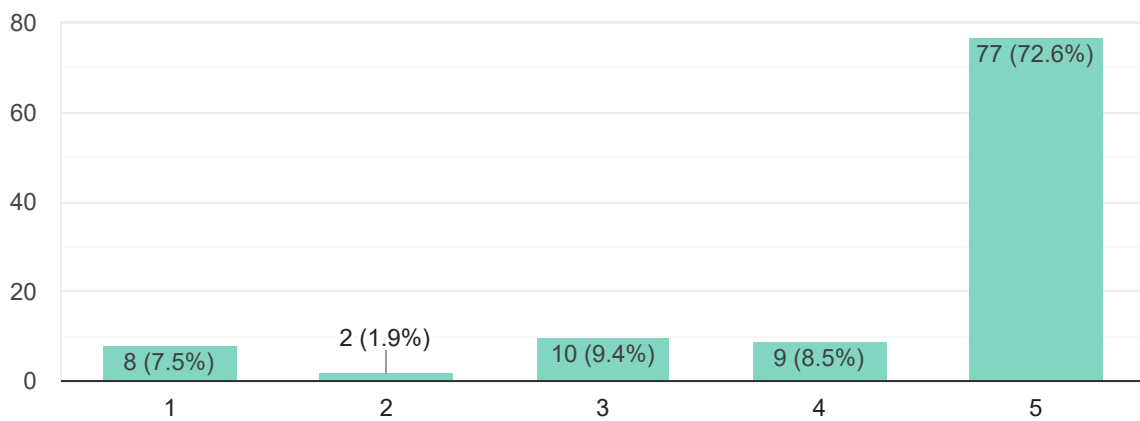

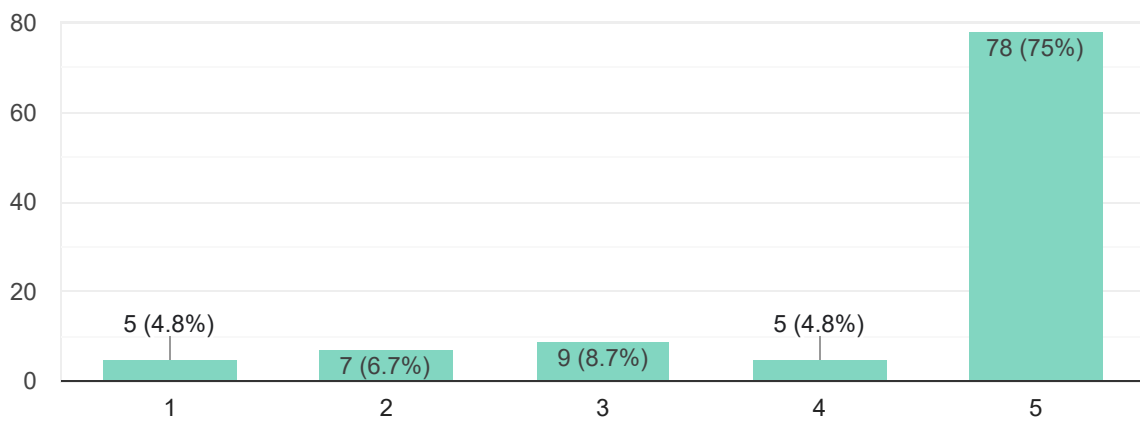

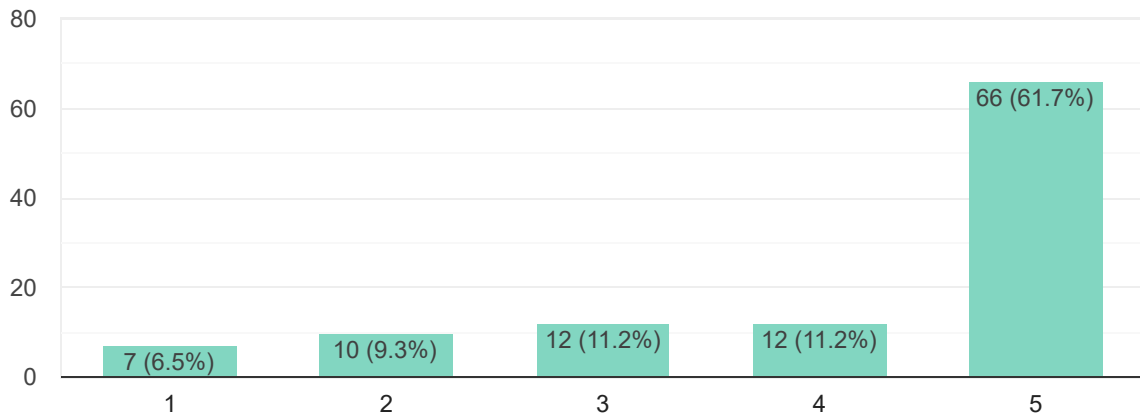

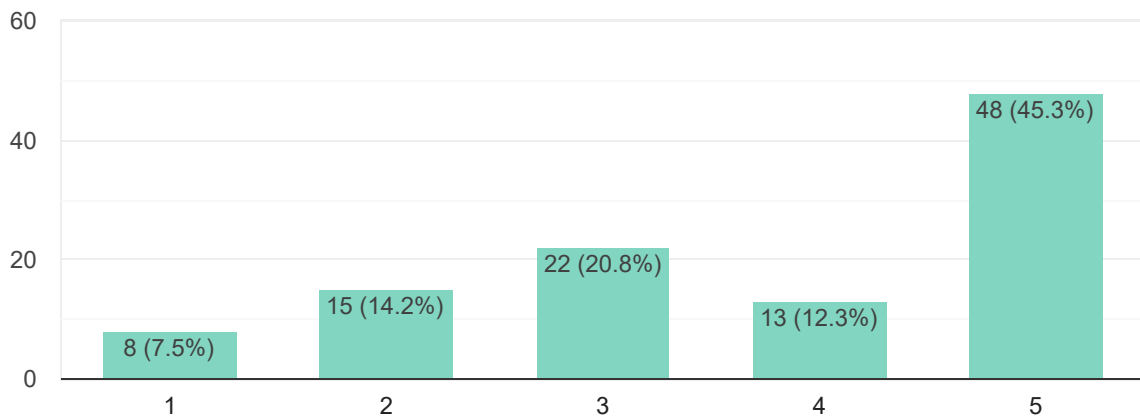

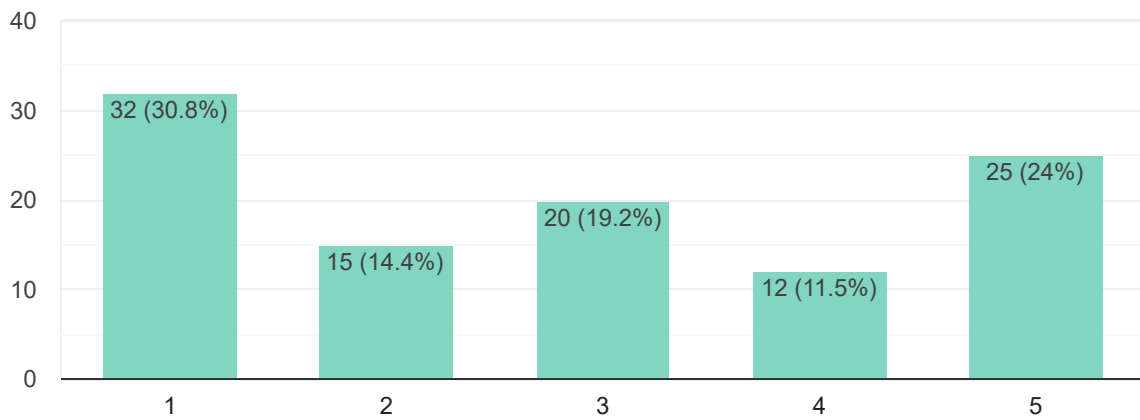

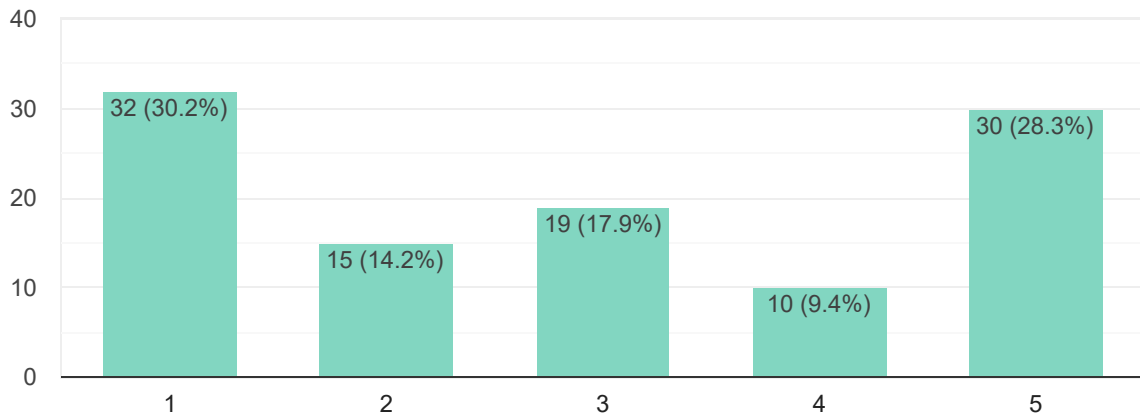

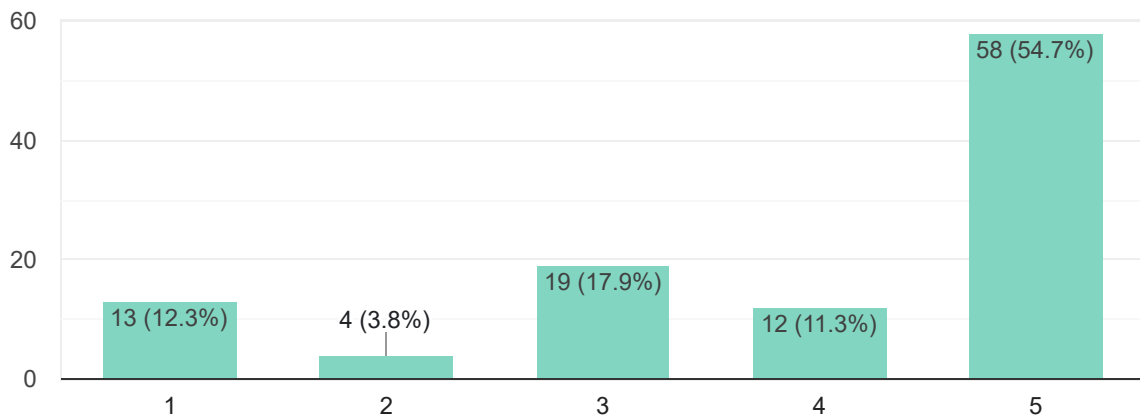

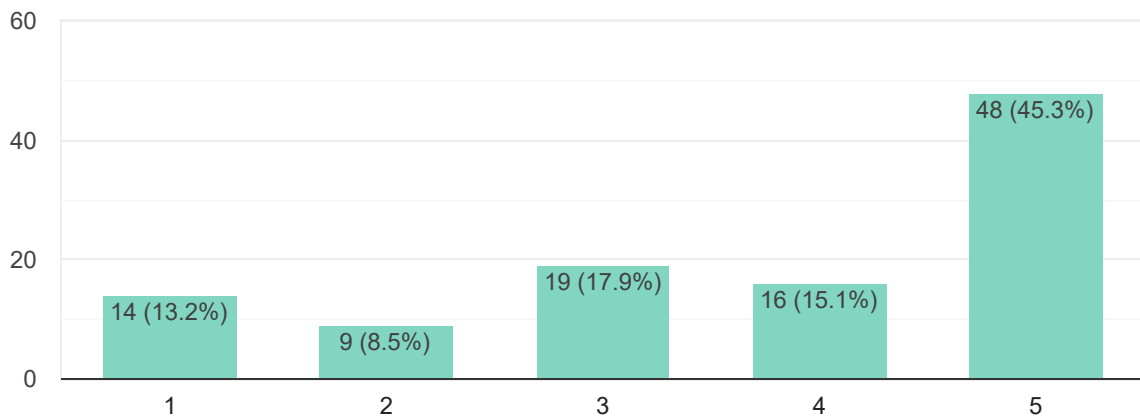

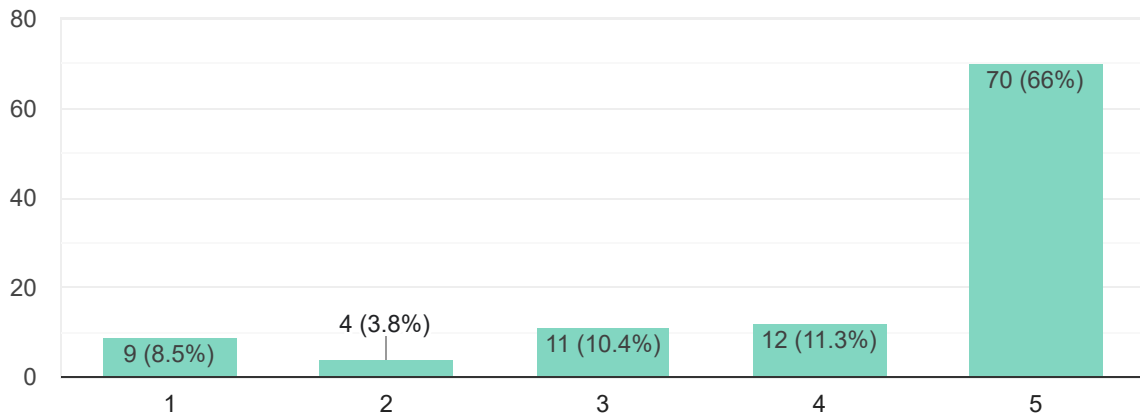

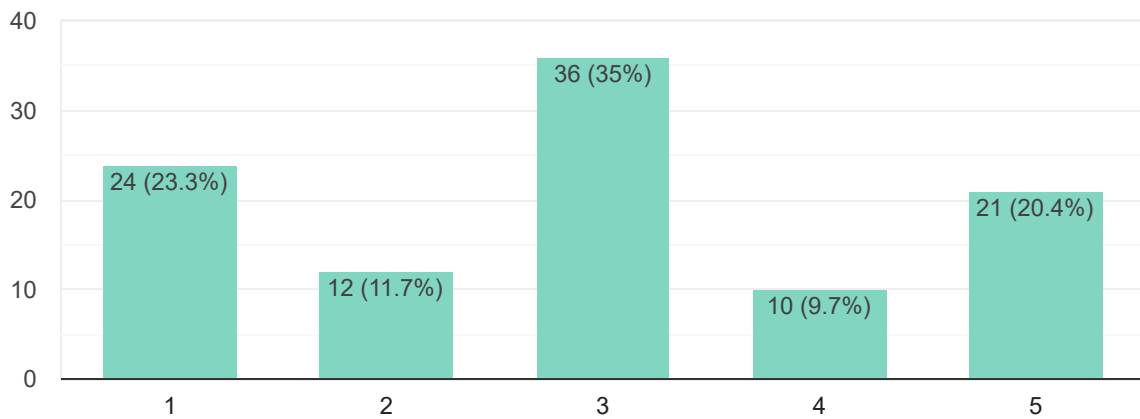

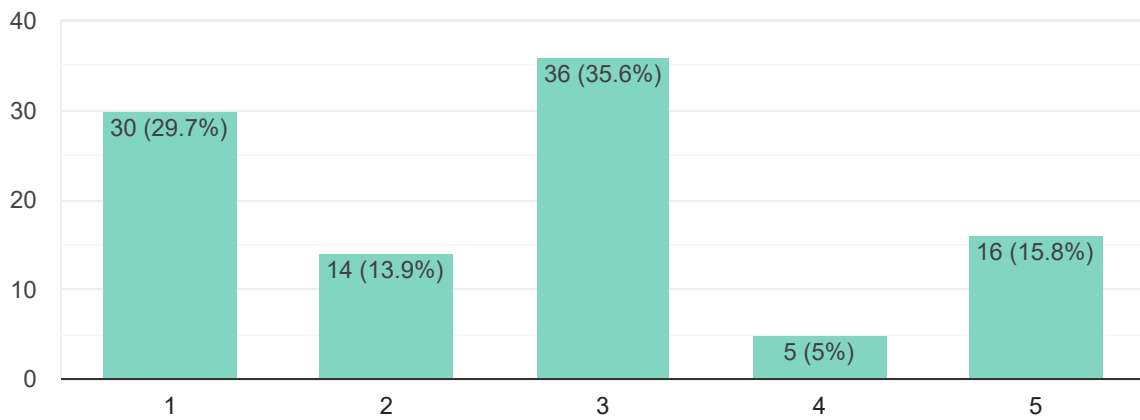

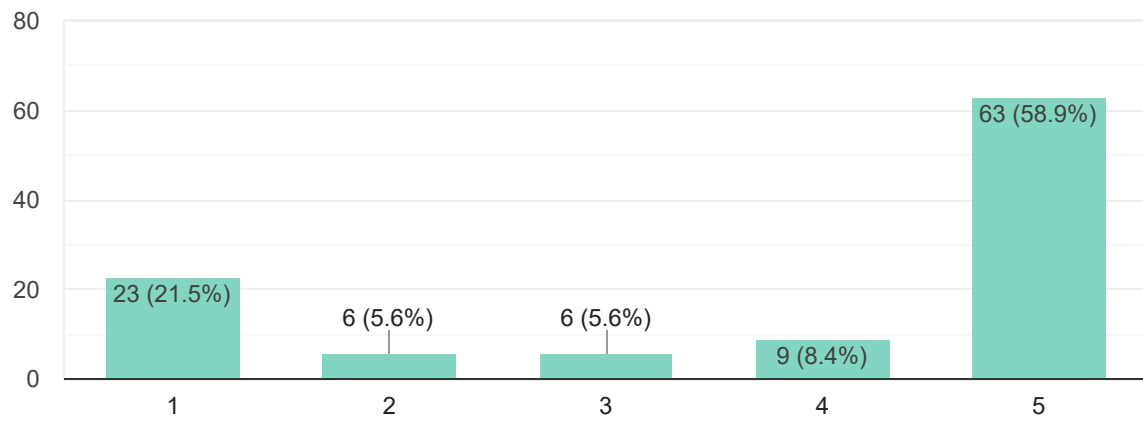

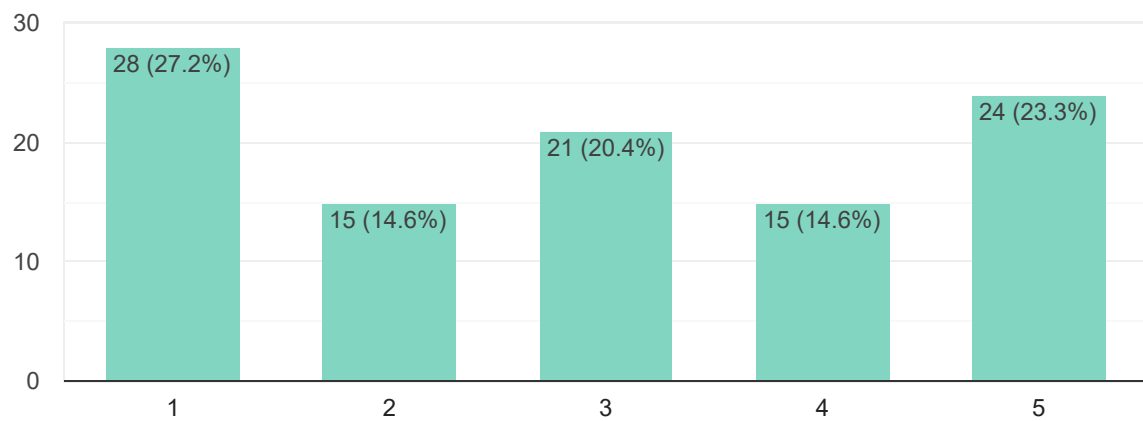

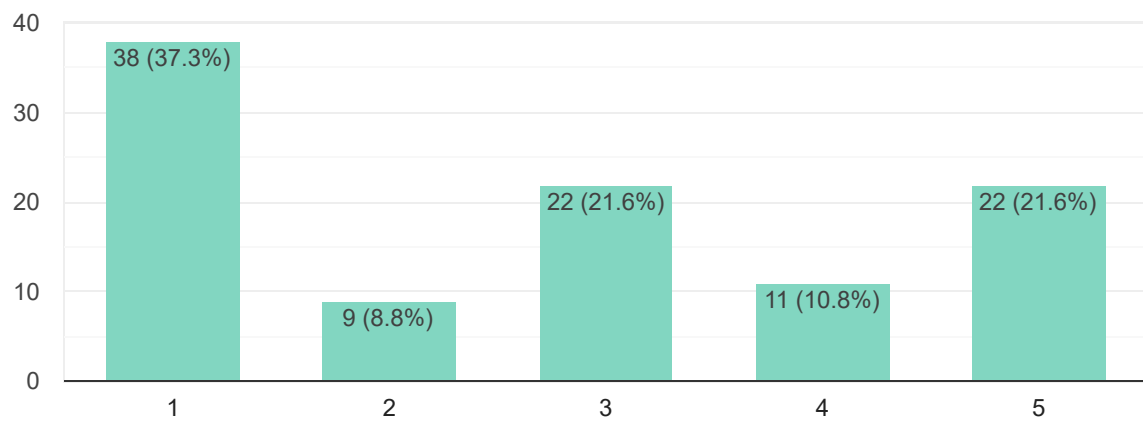

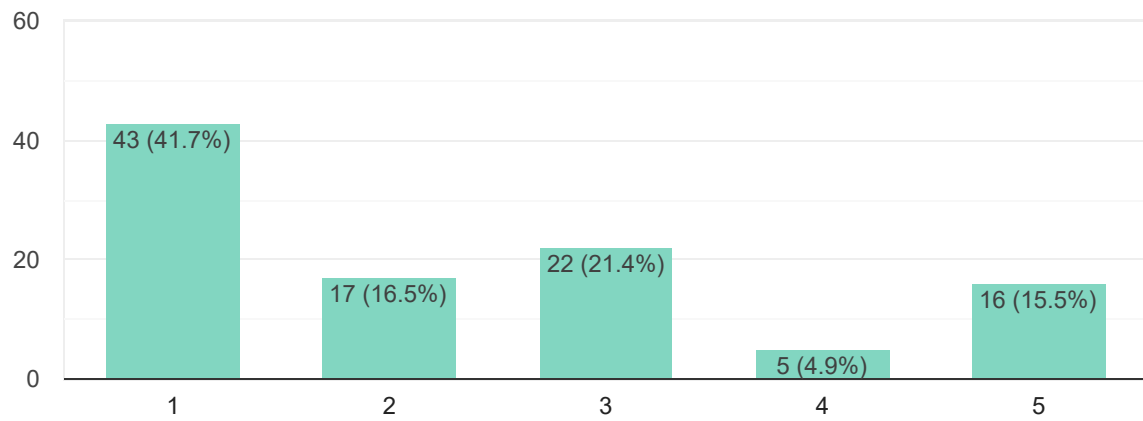

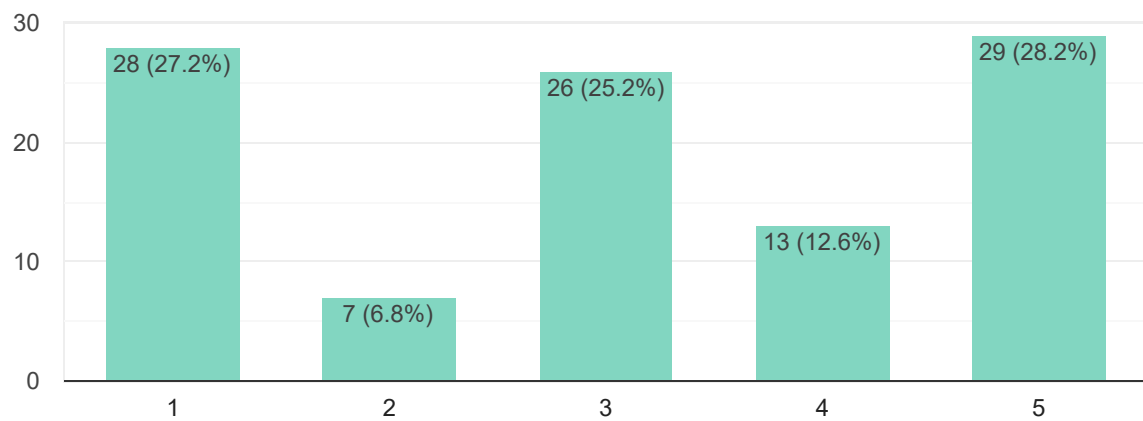

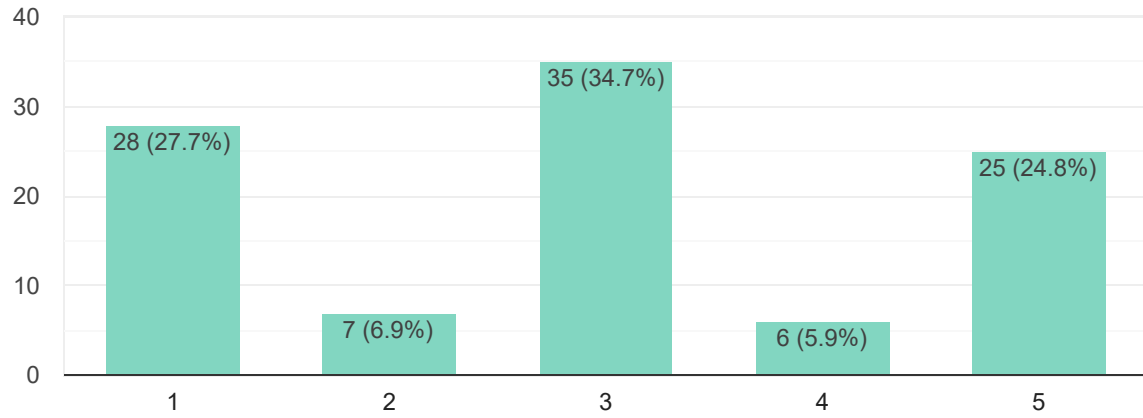

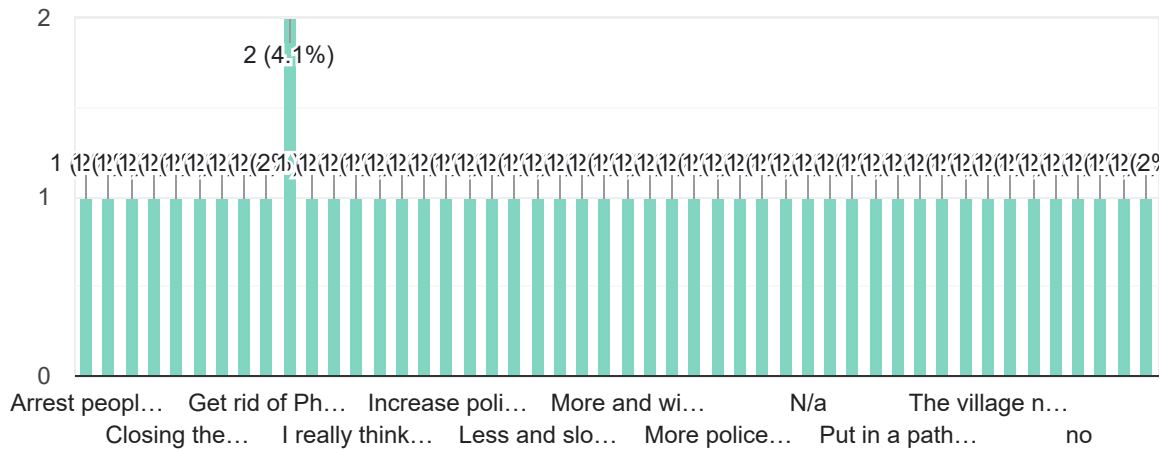

The fact my kids can't go anywhere on their bikes because there are no sidewalks along Army.

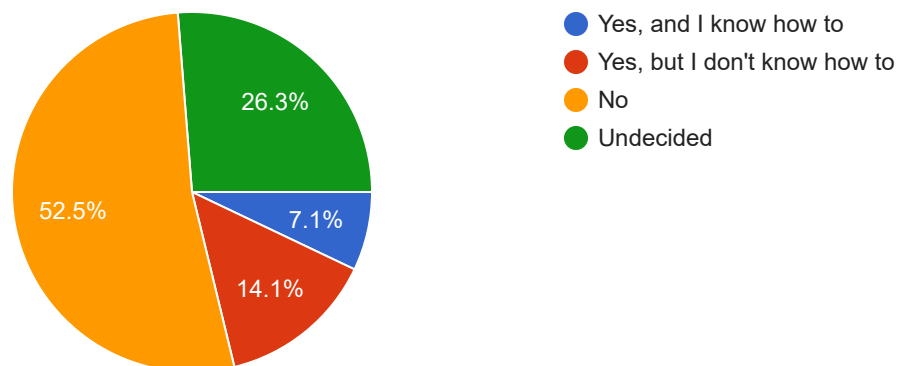
