50ml gin, 25ml strawberry syrup, 10ml lemon juice, 1 Garnish Blackberry, lemon wedge, mint sprig

teaspoon sugar, 20ml Crème de Mure

Glass - Old fashioned or tumbler

Ice - Crushed

Method

Add 10ml lemon juice and 1 teaspoon sugar into glass

Stir

Fill glass three quarters full with crushed ice Add 50ml gin



Add 25ml strawberry syrup





Want a Winter dish that reminds you of warmer climes? Tuck in to this crispy Korean chicken, created by Keiran Heavey, head chef at **Embleton Spa Hotel**









Recipe

Crispy Korean Chicken

SERVES 4

INGREDIENTS

For the sauce

2 tbsp Gochujang red chilli paste

2/3 minced garlic cloves 4 tbsp corn flour

3 tbsp soy sauce

1 inch ginger

1 tbsp sesame oil

1 tbsp Mirin rice wine

1 tbsp rice wine vinegar

3 tsp honey

2 tbsp brown sugar

For the crispy coating

5 boneless & skinless chicken thighs cut into chunks

200ml buttermilk

1 egg white

150g plain flour

1 tsp salt

1/2 tsp celery salt

1/2 tsp garlic powder 1 tsp black pepper

METHOD

- 1. Mix the sauce ingredients together in a bowl then pour into a pan and bring to the boil, stirring until sugar is dissolved. Move to one side and leave to cool.
- 2. To make the crispy chicken, first cut the chicken into bite-sized chunks and place in a bowl. Add the egg white, buttermilk, celery salt and black pepper.
- 3. Mix together, cover and place in the fridge to marinade for at least an hour, though overnight is
- 4. Mix the flour, cornflour, garlic powder and salt. Add marinated chicken thighs into flour mixture.
- 5. Heat oil to 160C & fry chicken for 2-3 mins, then remove and turn oil up to 190C and refry chicken until golden, in around 1-3 mins.

Tip - best served with sticky rice & nori seaweed.

GROW A BOTTLE GARDEN

Oakhurst Garden Centre

A Christmas terrarium, or bottle garden, could be a special gift for a plant-loving friend.

You will need:
A large glass vessel or jar
Horticultural grit
Houseplant or terrarium compost
Activated charcoal
A selection of small foliage plants
Decorative rocks and moss for the
top of the compost
Optional sprig of holly with
berries, fairy lights and Christmas
ribbon

The process

- 1. Place a 5mm layer of gravel in the bottom of your vessel for drainage.
- 2. Add a layer of activated charcoal on top of the gravel followed by enough compost to accommodate your plants. Use a funnel if your bottle is narrow necked.
- 3. Remove your plants from their pots and loosen any roots into the compost and firm them down well. You can use telescopic terrarium tools to help here.
- 4. Slowly add water to the inside of the bottle making sure it gets to all parts of the compost.
- 5. If you are adding a lid to seal your garden let it sit for a week first. It will then look after itself. Remove the lid temporarily if there is an excess of water until the moisture goes.
- 6. To make it Christmas themed, add a sprig of holly at the front. Entwine a small set of fairy lights around the foliage inside the glass. Tie a red ribbon around the neck or use double sided tape to adhere to the side. 7. Place in a bright position out of full sun and see your garden grow



Glitz glamour

PERFECT PRINTS

Market Place Print Studio
Lino printing can be used for
a variety of festive activities

- Christmas cards, wrapping
paper, gift tags, gifts or
decorations. It involves using
tools to carve out a design, then
ink is rolled on to the surface
and the image is printed on
to paper or fabric. One of the
joys of lino printing is it can be
done at home and is relatively
inexpensive – once your lino
block is carved you'll get

hundreds of prints from it.

Cockermouth Art & Craft has the supplies you'll need for this project, and, in the lead up to Christmas we're offering a range of festive workshops including Print Your Own Decoration and Block Printing Festive Bunting. www.marketplaceprintstudio.co.uk

The process

- 1. Draw your design and copy it on to lino. Your design will flip when you print it so any text must be written backwards. Use tracing paper to help you flip and transfer your design.
- 2. Carve out the design. Everything you carve away will not print. Always carve away from yourself.
- 3. Roll relief ink onto a flat surface to evenly cover the roller and then roll the ink over the lino.
- 4. Place paper on top and apply pressure. Rubbing with the back of a wooden spoon works well! Make sure the paper doesn't move.
- 5. Peel off the paper and leave to dry. Ink up again for multiple prints.





The people of Cockermouth have proved their resilience on more than one occasion, but there's one which sticks in everybody's minds - the floods of 2009, 15 years ago this November. Unusually for a major weather event, the rest of the country was barely affected so Cockermouth and its surrounding towns and villages made the international headlines.

The town bounced back in magnificent style when the community pulled together, only to be tested again in 2015 when Storm Desmond hit. The lessons learned led to the creation of one brilliant organisation, Cockermouth Emergency Response Group. Its volunteers' amazing efforts were recognised by the late Queen's Award for Voluntary Service - the equivalent of an MBE for volunteer groups. We asked the team what CERG offers the community.

Why was Cockermouth **Emergency Response** Group set up?

After the floods of 2015, the County Council recognised how effective the volunteer response had been in particular that of the voluntary groups like Cockermouth Flood Action Group, Rotary, Churches Together and Cockermouth WI. In 2015, in addition to a respite centre, The Bridge Cafe was set up as a space for affected householders to share experiences and find comfort in talking to others. Kings Church took this over and still run it every Tuesday and Friday.

Beyond flood preparation, what else do vou do?

We help in any emergency flooding, missing persons, power outages and pandemics. The latter was only a theoretical item in our emergency plan but, of course, Covid changed all that. We were getting requests for help that we could respond to quickly and effectively even before the statutory authorities.

How many volunteers do you have and what do they do?

Approximately 230. We help direct people's queries about flood prevention in advance of possible weather events. We watch the rivers, lake levels and weather reports so that we can bring our experience to bear on how we think it will go. In the Covid pandemic we did just about everything - from fixing chairlifts and dog walking, to collecting and delivering shopping. Our volunteers gave more than 4.500 hours of their time at the vaccination clinics, which, if the surgery had needed to pay, would

have cost £50,000. No matter what the request, someone always came forward to help. In power outages we also offer a door knocking service as we envisage there might not be mobile phones or social media. We also help people get hot food and drinks and we are exploring getting a generator.

How can people use CERG's services to look after themselves?

If a householder or business registers, we give them advice on how to prepare. If they share difficulties they might have we prioritise them appropriately. We warn people via email and social media if a flood alert is issued and it helps them know whether they should travel to town or put up flood defences.

How can people help

Tell friends, family members and neighbours about us. Encourage them to register via our website or by collecting a form from Cockermouth Library. Please don't just forget about this article - keep us in mind if you meet someone who could benefit from our help. We always welcome new volunteers as well!





How long have you lived in Cockermouth?

I grew up in Great Broughton so I was in and around Cockermouth until the age of 18. In 2016 I moved to Loughborough for university and to concentrate on swimming full time but my parents still live locally so I come up and visit whenever I can.

Tell me about your activities in town?

I attended Cockermouth School from 2009 and 2016 and I was a member of Cockermouth Swimming Club between the ages of eight to 18. The club allowed me to achieve success at a junior level and set the foundations for me go on to win Olympic medals. The club is entirely voluntary run and is incredibly fortunate to have dedicated coaches like Sean Balmer and Eleanor Walsh who've helped me to get to where I am today.

What else do you get up to when you're not swimming?

After competing at the Paris Olympics, I took part in the national three peaks challenge to raise money for a charity in Zambia called Sport in Action. Last year I took some

time away from the pool and went out there to work with their team for a couple of weeks. My coach in Loughborough, Mel Marshall, has been fundraising for them for 15 or so years and it was really good to see firsthand the amazing work they do setting up grass roots sport in local communities.

Your disqualification in the 2024 Olympics was heartbreaking to watch how do you move on from that and prepare for your next challenge?

Paris was a tough one. I felt like I was in really good shape and that I could have been challenging for a medal. Unfortunately I just went a bit too far underwater off my start in the heat. But I've also been competing at a high level for a long time and I know that you can't dwell on these kind of setbacks, I've had plenty of disappointments throughout my career but they make the high points much more worth it. I'm currently taking a bit of a break from swimming but once I get back in I'll be more motivated than ever to try to improve and work toward Los Angeles in 2028.

Describe your perfect day out and about in and around Cockermouth?

Whenever I'm back, I love going to the many pubs the town has to offer! It's mainly to catch up with friends, but I usually end up bumping into someone else I know too which is always nice. I also always try to make an effort to get into the lakes and out on the fells, providing the weather is relatively dry. It's something I probably appreciate more now I've moved away from the area.

If you had to recommend one thing in town to a visitor,

I always like walking along the river when it's a nice day, but when I was still swimming here I used to love it when the Taste Cumbria food festival was on. We used to finish training on a Saturday morning then head into town for something


