## Policy and Procedure for Granting Full Membership Status

(Approved by unanimous vote at General Meeting of October 19, 2009)

The purpose of this policy is to set minimum criteria for consideration of Associate Members for Full Member status in Reik Felag.

When assessing eligibility of Associate Members for Full Member status serious consideration will be given to the following criteria :

- 1) The member should have held Associate Member status for at least one full year.
- 2) The member should have attended four (4) or more meetings of which one is preferred to be the Annual General Meeting
- 3) ) The member should possess the basic period clothing for characters living in the Viking Age and its region of influence.

### **MINIMUM CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS FOR REIK FELAG MEMBERS**

Men: tunic, pants, belt, shoes, under tunic is optional according to your character

Women: dress, belt, shoes, appropriate head covering for character, under dress and apron are optional according to your character.

Specifications for the above are found in the **Authenticity and Norse Clothing Kit Standards** document. Those playing non-Norse characters should consult sponsors regarding appropriate clothing.

- 4)The member should have participated in at least two (2) official Reik Felag events.
- 5) The member should have worked at events on set-up and/or take-down as part of the Reik Felag team.
- 6) The member should have demonstrated their performance as a suitable and productive member of Reik Felag.

## Membership in Reik Felag

There are two categories of membership set out in our By-laws:

### Article 1. Section 1.1 Full Members

(8) Full members are voting members and have the right to vote on all Society issues, the right to hold office and the right to participate in all Reik Felag activities. Full members are those in good standing with paid annual memberships.

### Section 1.2 Associate Members

(9) Associate Members have the right to participate in all Reik Felag activities but are non-voting members and cannot vote on group issues and cannot hold office. They can chair committees and assist in administration of events.

## Eligibility for Full Membership

After a full year as an Associate Member you may be eligible to become a Full Member. This will be decided on by a vote of the Full Members after you have met the minimum criteria as set out in our Policy for Approval of New Full Members.

You may petition for approval as a Full Member if you meet these criteria:

- Held Associate Membership for one full year
- Attended at least four (4) meetings of the Society, 1 of which is the Annual General Meeting
- Participated in at least two (2) official Reik Felag events
- Acquired the approved Norse period clothing
- *Volunteered with set-up and take-down as part of the Reik Felag work team*
